Word Study for --- FRANKINCENSE




Exo 30:34 And the LORD said unto Moses, Take unto thee sweet spices, stacte, and onycha, and galbanum; [mix these] sweet spices with pure frankincense: of each shall there be a like weight:

**Lev 02:01 And when any will offer a
meat offering unto the LORD, his
offering shall be of fine flour; and he
shall pour oil upon it, and put
frankincense thereon:**

Lev 02:02 And he shall bring it to Aaron's sons the priests: and he shall take thereout his handful of the flour thereof, and of the oil thereof, with all the frankincense thereof; and the priest shall burn the memorial of it upon the altar, [to be] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD:

**Lev 02:15 And thou shalt put oil upon it,
and lay frankincense thereon: it [is] a
meat offering.**



Lev 02:16 And the priest shall burn the memorial of it, [part] of the beaten corn thereof, and [part] of the oil thereof, with all the frankincense thereof: [it is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

Lev 5:11 But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, then he that sinned shall bring for his offering the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering; he shall put no oil upon it, neither shall he put any frankincense thereon: for it is a sin offering.

Lev 06:15 And he shall take of it his handful, of the flour of the meat offering, and of the oil thereof, and all the frankincense which is upon the meat offering, and shall burn it upon the altar for a sweet savour, even the memorial of it, unto the LORD.


**Lev 24:07 And thou shalt put pure
frankincense upon [each] ^{loaf}, that it
may be on the bread for a memorial, [
even] an offering made by fire unto
the LORD.**

Num 05:15 Then shall the man bring his wife unto the priest, and he shall bring her offering for her, the tenth part of an ephah of barley meal; he shall pour no oil upon it, nor put frankincense thereon: for it is an offering of jealousy, an offering of memorial, bringing iniquity to remembrance.

1Ch 09:29 [Some] of them also [were] appointed to oversee the vessels and all the instruments of the sanctuary, and the fine flour, and the wine, and the oil, and the frankincense, and the spices.


**Neh 13:05 And he had prepared for him
a great chamber, where aforetime
they laid the meat offerings, the
frankincense, and the vessels, and the
tithes of the corn, the new wine, and
the oil, which was commanded [to be
given] to the Levites, and the singers,
and the porters; and the offerings of
the priests.**

Neh 13:09 Then I commanded, and they cleansed the chambers: and thither brought I again the vessels of the house of God, with the meat offering and the frankincense.



**Son 03:06 Who [is] this that cometh
out of the wilderness like pillars of
smoke, perfumed with myrrh and
frankincense, with all powders of the
merchant?**

**Son 04:06 Until the day break, and the
shadows flee away, I will get me to the
mountain of myrrh, and to the hill of
frankincense.**

and chariots, and slaves, and souls of
