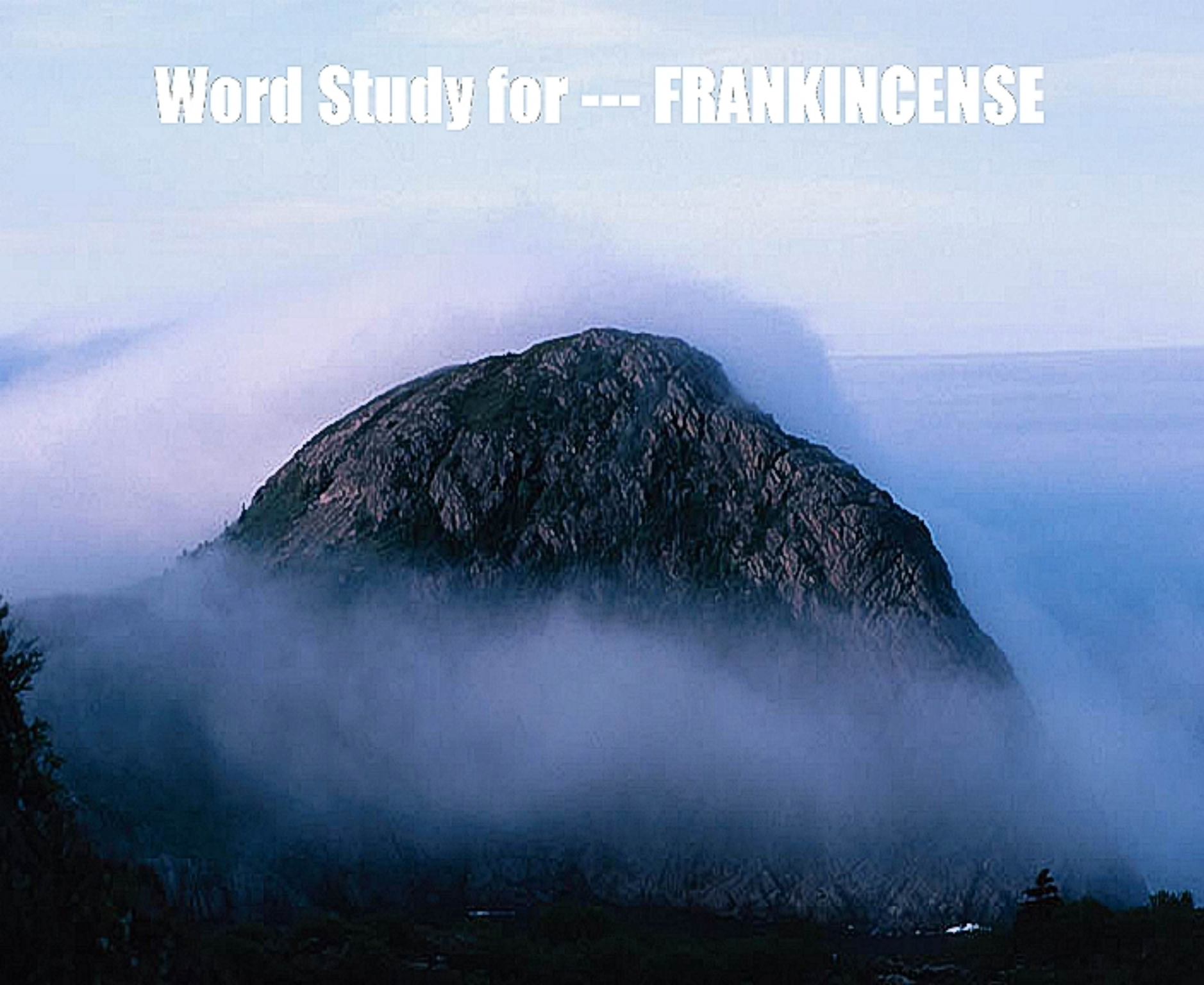

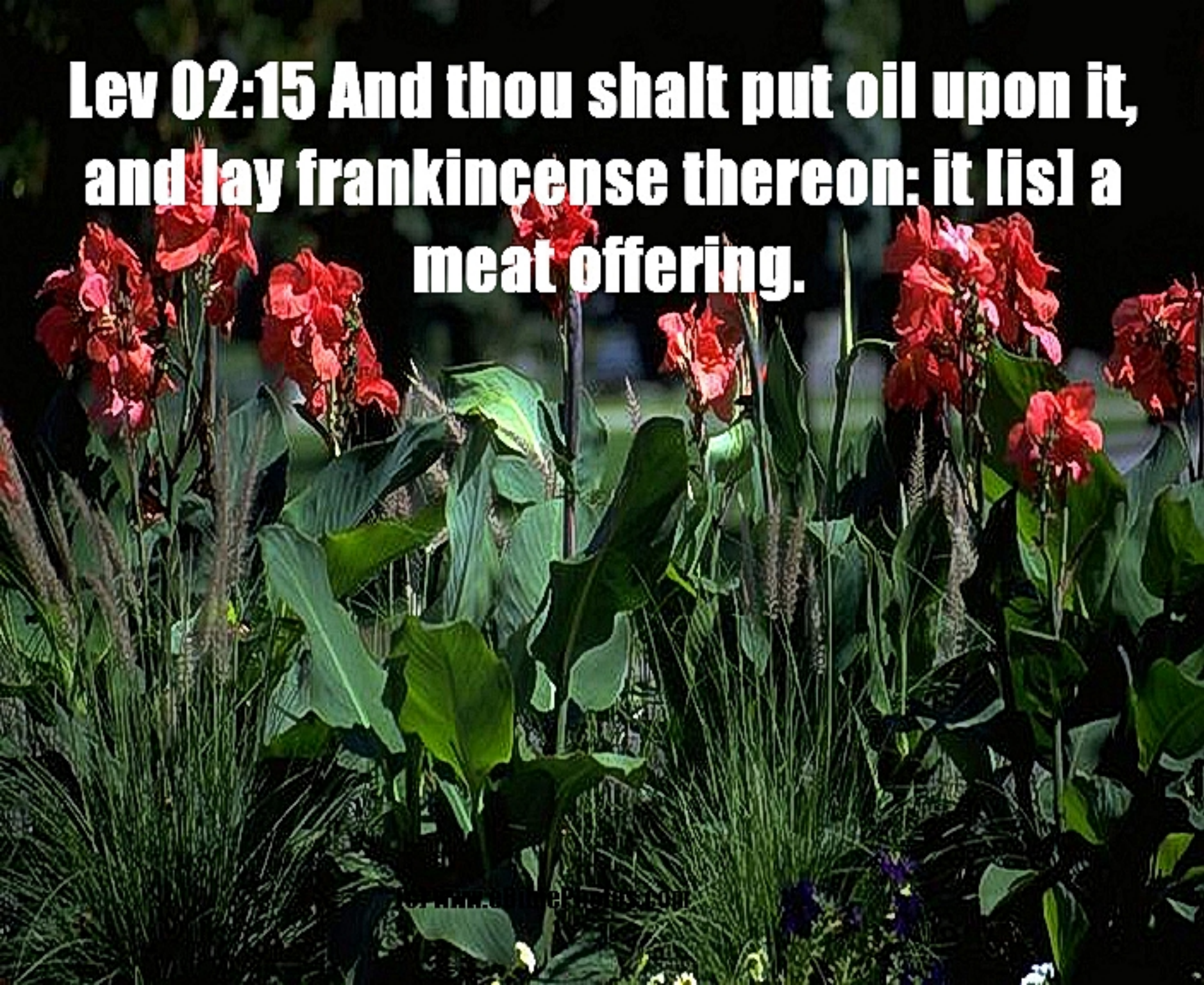



meat offering.**






**Lev 24:07 And thou shalt put pure frankincense upon each row, that it may be on the bread for a memorial, I even) an offering made by fire unto the LORD.**

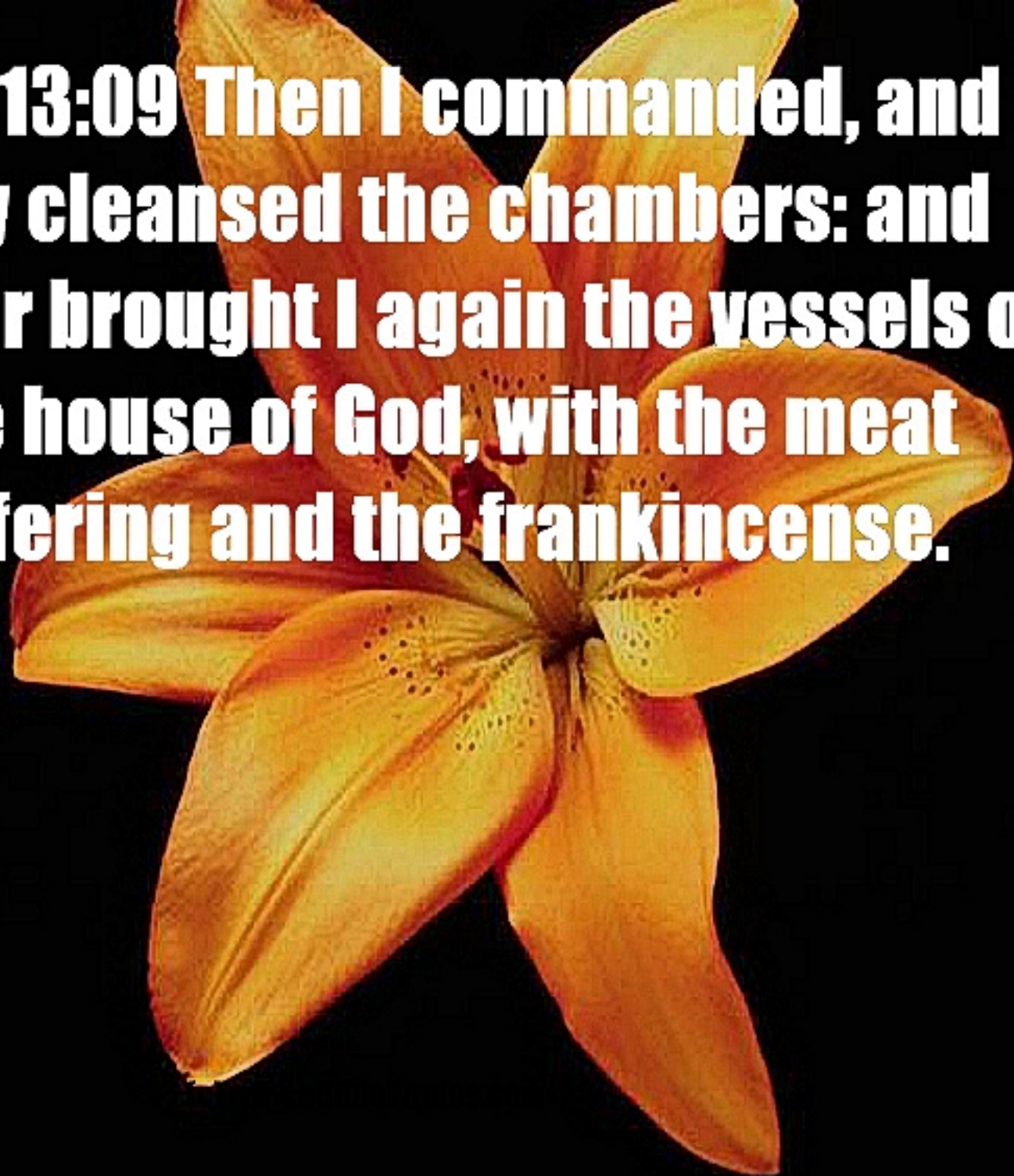




