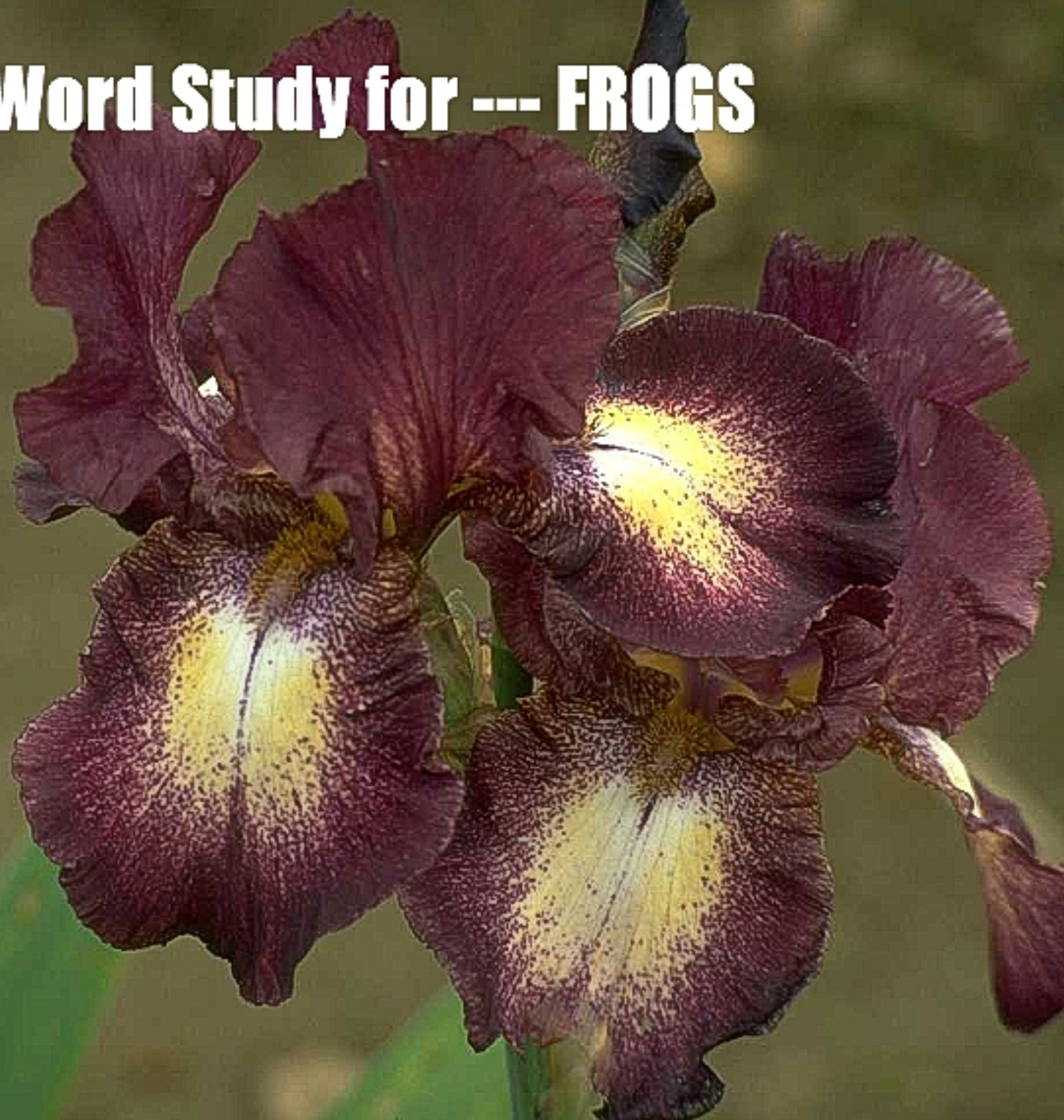



Exo 08:02 And if thou refuse to let [them] go, behold, I will smite all thy borders with frogs:

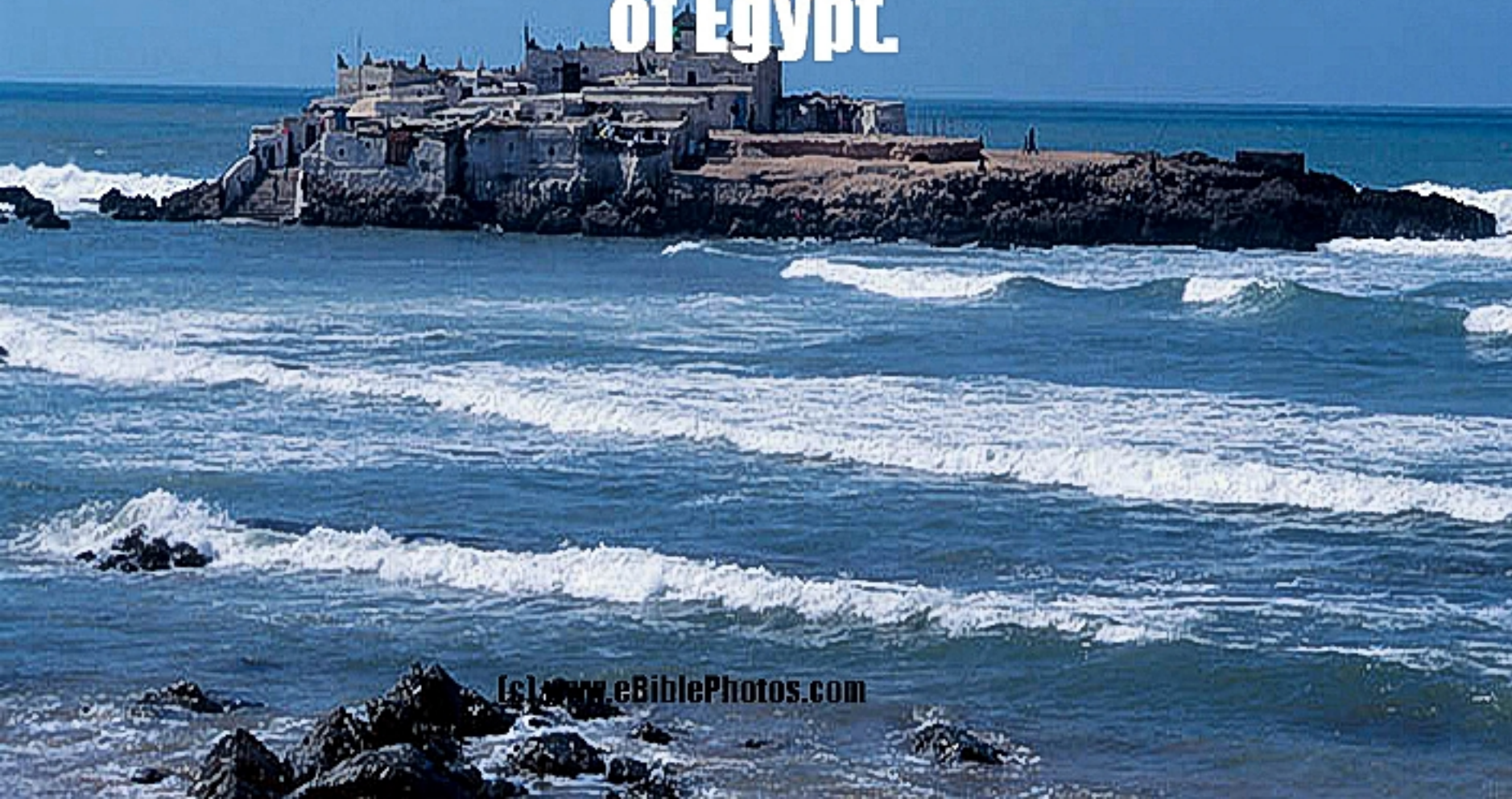

upon all thy servants.**




**Exo 08:05 And the LORD spake unto


