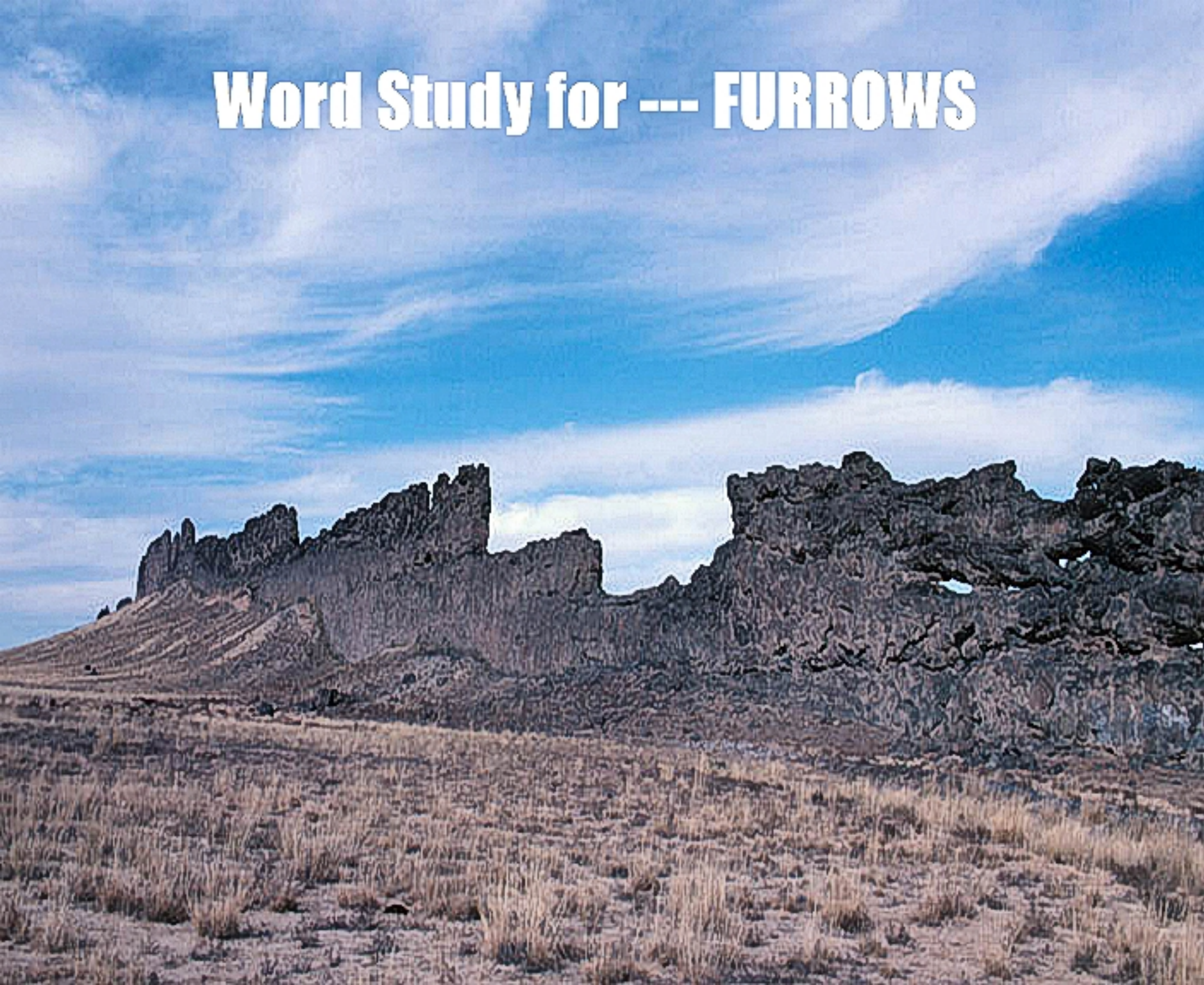






**Job 31:38 If my land cry against me, or


