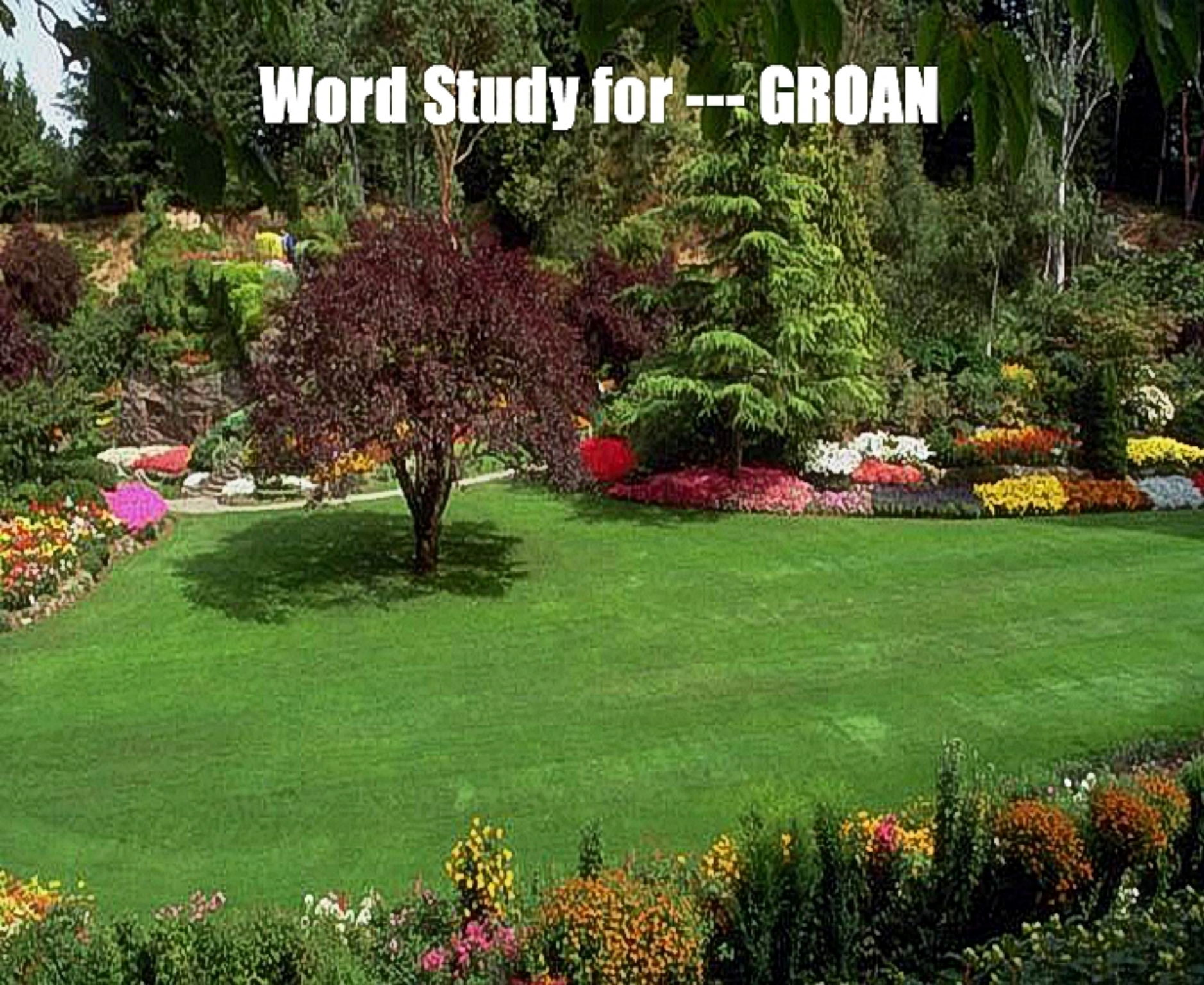

**Job 24:12 Men groan from out of the city, and the soul of the wounded crieth out: yet God layeth not folly to them .**


**Jer 51:52 Wherefore, behold, the days

shall groan.**






**Joe 01:18 How do the beasts groan! the
