

**Gen 21:33 And Abraham planted a grove
In Beersheba, and called there on the
name of the LORD, the everlasting God.**

**Deu 16:21 Thou shalt not plant thee a
grove of any trees near unto the altar
of the LORD thy God, which thou shalt
make thee.**

**Jud 06:25 And it came to pass the
same night, that the LORD said unto
him, Take thy father's young bullock,
even the second bullock of seven
years old, and throw down the altar of
Baal that thy father hath, and cut down
the grove that [is] by it:**

**Jud 06:26 And build an altar unto the
LORD thy God upon the top of this rock,
in the ordered place, and take the
second bullock, and offer a burnt
sacrifice with the wood of the grove
which thou shalt cut down.**

**Jud 06:28 And when the men of the city
arose early in the morning, behold, the
altar of Baal was cast down, and the
grove was cut down that was by it, and
the second bullock was offered upon
the altar that was built.**

**Jud 06:30 Then the men of the city
said unto Joash, Bring out thy son, that
he may die: because he hath cast
down the altar of Baal, and because he
hath cut down the grove that I wasl by
it.**

**1Ki 15:13 And also Maachah his mother,
even her he removed from being queen,
because she had made an idol in a
grove; and Asa destroyed her idol, and
burnt it by the brook Kidron.**

**1Ki 16:33 And Ahab made a grove; and
Ahab did more to provoke the LORD
God of Israel to anger than all the
kings of Israel that were before him.**

**2Ki 13:06 Nevertheless they departed
not from the sins of the house of
Jeroboam, who made Israel sin, [but]
walked therein: and there remained
the grove also in Samaria.**

2Ki 17:16 And they left all the commandments of the LORD their God, and made them molten images, [even] two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal.


2Ki 21:03 For he built up again the high places which Hezekiah his father had destroyed; and he reared up altars for Baal, and made a grove, as did Ahab king of Israel; and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them.

**2Ki 21:07 And he set a graven image of
the grove that he had made in the
house, of which the LORD said to David,
and to Solomon his son, In this house,
and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen
out of all tribes of Israel, will I put my
name for ever:**

2Ki 23:04 And the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest, and the priests of the second order, and the keepers of the door, to bring forth out of the temple of the LORD all the vessels that were made for Baal, and for the grove, and for all the host of heaven: and he burned them without Jerusalem in the fields of Kidron, and carried the ashes of them unto Bethel.

**2Ki 23:06 And he brought out the
grove from the house of the LORD,
without Jerusalem, unto the brook
Kidron, and burned it at the brook
Kidron, and stamped it small to
powder, and cast the powder thereof
upon the graves of the children of the
people.**

2Ki 23:07 And he brake down the houses of the sodomites, that [were] by the house of the LORD, where the women wove hangings for the grove.



2Ki 23:15 Moreover the altar that [was] at Bethel, [and] the high place which Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, had made, both that altar and the high place he brake down, and burned the high place, [and] stamped [it] small to powder, and burned the grove.

**2Ch 15:16 And also [concerning]
Maachah the mother of Asa the king,
he removed her from [being] queen,
because she had made an idol in a
grove: and Asa cut down her idol, and
stamped [it], and burnt [it] at the brook
Kidron.**
