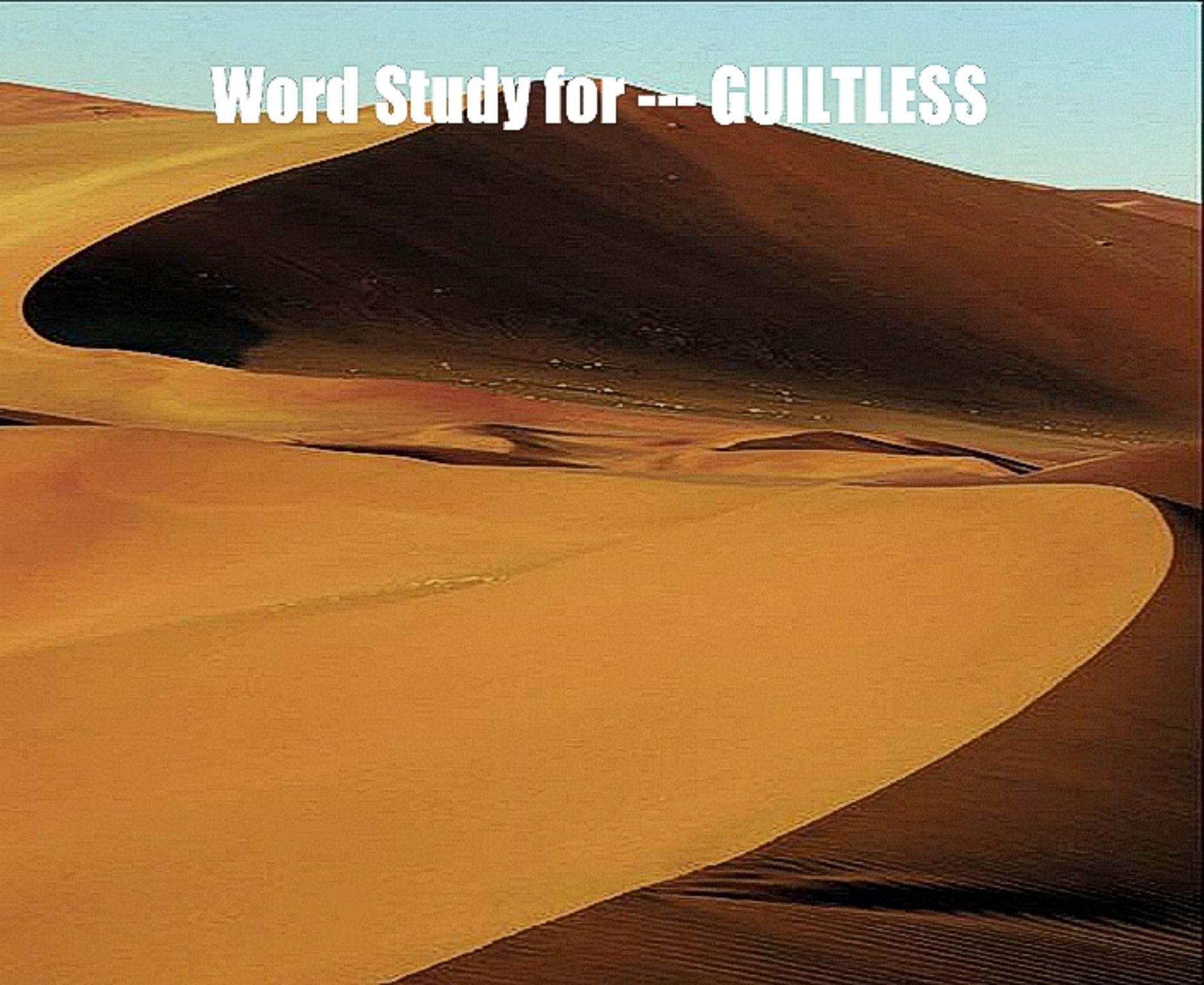




**Exo 20:07 Thou shalt not take the name

woman shall bear her iniquity.**


**Num 32:22 And the land be subdued
