

**Gen 18:14 Is any thing too hard for the  
LORD? At the time appointed I will  
return unto thee, according to the time  
of life, and Sarah shall have a son.**

**Gen 35:16 And they journeyed from Bethel; and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: and Rachel travailed, and she had hard labour.**

**Gen 35:17 And it came to pass, when she  
was in hard labour, that the midwife  
said unto her, Fear not; thou shalt have  
this son also.**

**Exo 01:14 And they made their lives  
bitter with hard bondage, in mortar,  
and in brick, and in all manner of  
service in the field: all their service,  
wherein they made them serve, [was]  
with rigour.**



**Exo 18:26 And they judged the people  
at all seasons: the hard causes they  
brought unto Moses, but every small  
matter they judged themselves.**

**1Ch 19:04 Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved them, and cut off their garments in the midst hard by their buttocks, and sent them away.**



hard.**


**Isa 14:03 And it shall come to pass in

hard for me?**


**Eze 03:05 For thou [art] not sent to a
