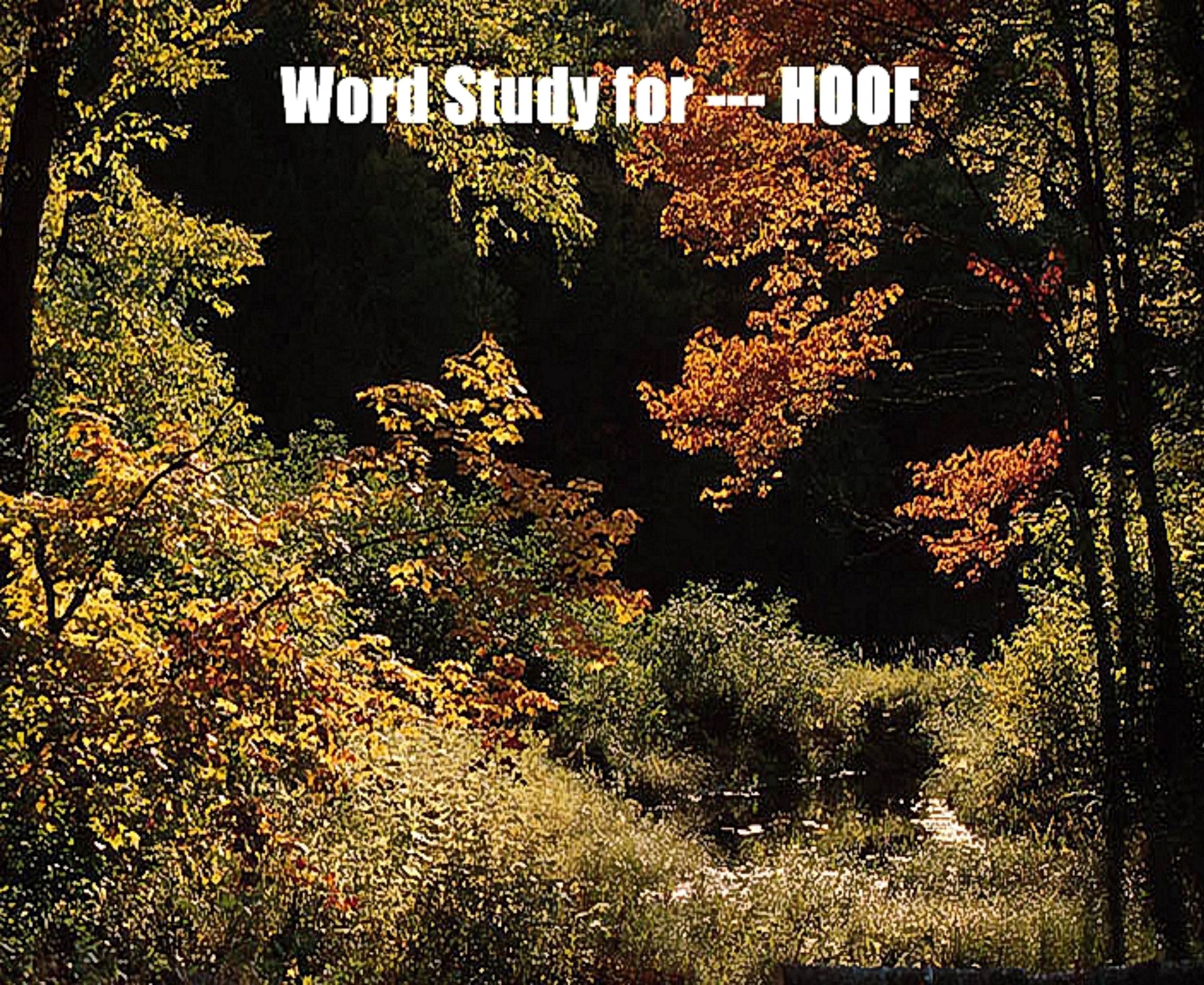




**Lev 11:03 Whatsoever parteth the hoof,

hoof; he [is] unclean unto you.**


