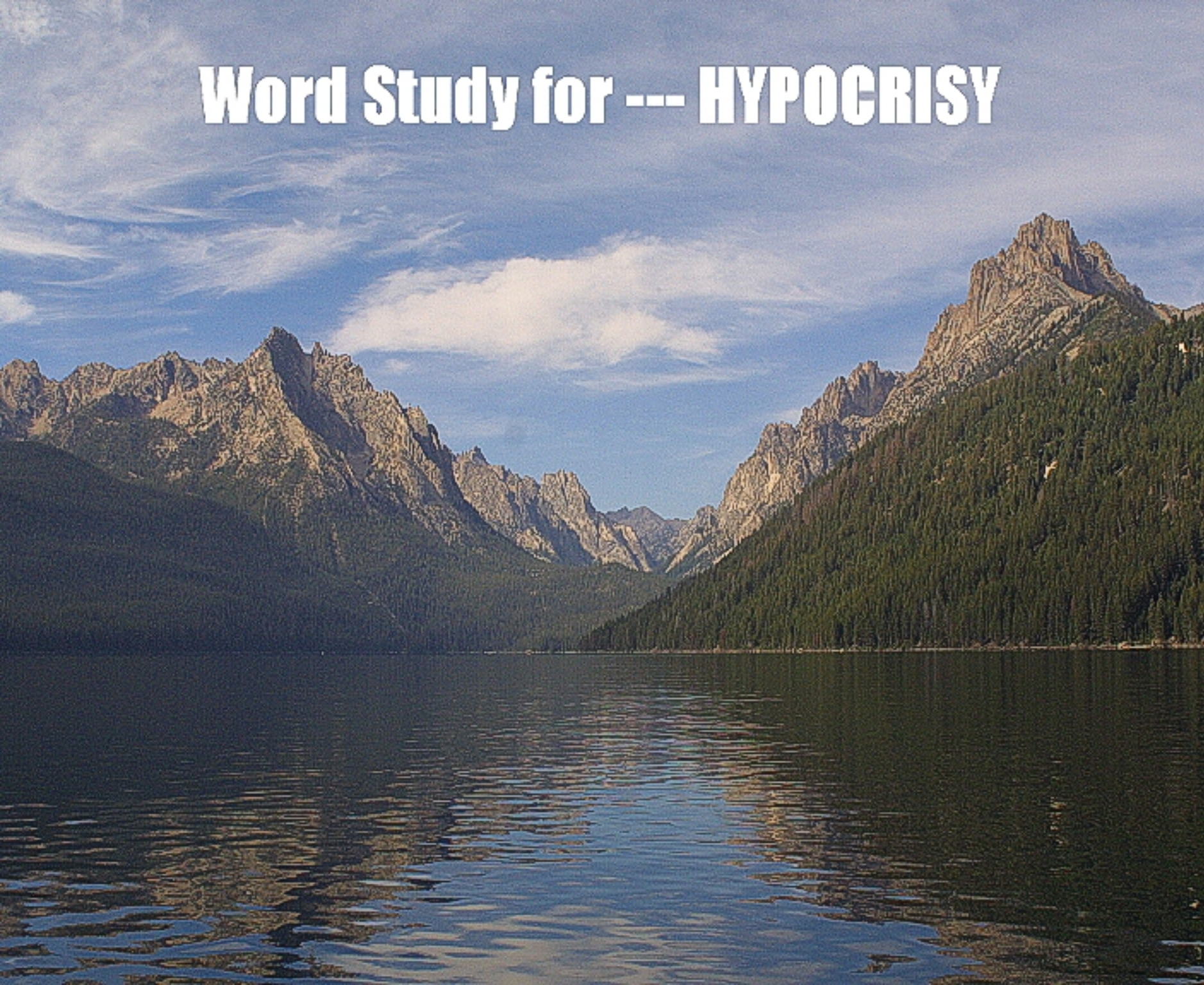


Word Study for --- HYPOCRISY


**Mat 23:28 Even so ye also outwardly
