




**Gen 06:05 And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.**

the land which I swear.**


**1Ch 29:18 O LORD God of Abraham,


**Jer 09:14 But have walked after the







