

**Gen 36:20 These are the sons of Seir  
the Horite, who inhabited the land;  
Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and  
Anah,**


**Exo 16:35 And the children of Israel did eat manna forty years, until they came to a land inhabited; they did eat manna, until they came unto the borders of the land of Canaan.**

**Lev 16:22 And the goat shall bear upon  
him all their iniquities unto a land not  
inhabited: and he shall let go the goat  
in the wilderness.**

**Jud 01:17 And Judah went with Simeon his brother, and they slew the Canaanites that inhabited Zephath, and utterly destroyed it. And the name of the city was called Hormah.**

**Jud 01:21 And the children of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites that inhabited Jerusalem; but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Benjamin in Jerusalem unto this day.**

**1Ch 05:09 And eastward he inhabited unto the entering in of the wilderness from the river Euphrates: because their cattle were multiplied in the land of Gilead.**



**Isa 13:20 It shall never be inhabited,  
neither shall it be dwelt in from  
generation to generation: neither  
shall the Arabian pitch tent there;  
neither shall the shepherds make  
their fold there.**

**Isa 44:26 That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:**

**Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I [am] the LORD; and [t]here is[**l**] none else.**

**Isa 54:03 For thou shalt break forth on  
the right hand and on the left; and thy  
seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and  
make the desolate cities to be  
inhabited.**

**Jer 06:08 Be thou instructed, O  
Jerusalem, lest my soul depart from  
thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land  
not inhabited.**

**Jer 17:06 For he shall be like the heath  
in the desert, and shall not see when  
good cometh; but shall inhabit the  
barched places in the wilderness, [in] a  
salt land and not inhabited.**

**Jer 22:06 For thus saith the LORD unto  
the king's house of Judah; Thou [art]  
Gilead unto me, [and] the head of  
Lebanon: [yet] surely I will make thee  
a wilderness, [and] cities [which] are  
not inhabited.**

**Jer 46:26 And I will deliver them into  
the hand of those that seek their lives,  
and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar  
king of Babylon, and into the hand of  
his servants: and afterward it shall be  
inhabited, as in the days of old, saith  
the LORD.**


**Jer 50:13 Because of the wrath of the  
LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it  
shall be wholly desolate: every one  
that goeth by Babylon shall be  
astonished, and hiss at all her plagues.**

**Jer 50:39 Therefore the wild beasts of  
the desert with the wild beasts of the  
islands shall dwell [therel], and the  
owls shall dwell therein: and it shall  
be no more inhabited for ever; neither  
shall it be dwelt in from generation to  
generation.**

**Eze 12:20 And the cities that are  
inhabited shall be laid waste, and the  
land shall be desolate; and ye shall  
know that I [am] the LORD.**

**Eze 26:17 And they shall take up a  
lamentation for thee, and say to thee,  
How art thou destroyed, that wast  
inhabited of seafaring men, the  
renowned city, which wast strong in the  
sea, she and her inhabitants, which  
cause their terror to be on all that  
haunt it!**

**Eze 26:19 For thus saith the Lord GOD;  
When I shall make thee a desolate  
city, like the cities that are not  
inhabited; when I shall bring up the  
deep upon thee, and great waters  
shall cover thee;**




**Eze 26:20 When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;**

**Eze 29:11 No foot of man shall pass  
through it, nor foot of beast shall pass  
through it, neither shall it be  
inhabited forty years.**

**Eze 34:13 And I will bring them out  
from the people, and gather them from  
the countries, and will bring them to  
their own land, and feed them upon  
the mountains of Israel by the rivers,  
and in all the inhabited places of the  
country.**

**Eze 36:10 And I will multiply men upon  
you, all the house of Israel, [even] all  
of it: and the cities shall be inhabited,  
and the wastes shall be builded:**



**Eze 36:35 And they shall say, This land  
that was desolate is become like the  
garden of Eden; and the waste and  
desolate and ruined cities have  
become fenced, [land] are inhabited.**

**Eze 38:12 To take a spoil, and to take a prey; to turn thine hand upon the desolate places [that are now] inhabited, and upon the people [that are] gathered out of the nations, which have gotten cattle and goods, that dwell in the midst of the land.**

**Zec 02:04 And said unto him, Run,  
speak to this young man, saying,  
Jerusalem shall be inhabited [as]  
towns without walls for the multitude  
of men and cattle therein:**

**Zec 07:07 Should ye not hear the words  
which the LORD hath cried by the  
former prophets, when Jerusalem was  
inhabited and in prosperity, and the  
cities thereof round about her, when  
men inhabited the south and the plain?**

**Zec 09:05 Ashkelon shall see [it], and  
fear; Gaza also [shall see it], and be  
very sorrowful, and Ekron; for her  
expectation shall be ashamed; and  
the king shall perish from Gaza, and  
Ashkelon shall not be inhabited.**

**Zec 12:06 In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, [even] in Jerusalem.**

**Zec 14:10 All the land shall be turned  
as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south  
of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up,  
and inhabited in her place, from  
Benjamin's gate unto the place of the  
first gate, unto the corner gate, and [  
from] the tower of Hananeel unto the  
king's winepresses.**

**Zec 14:11 And [men] shall dwell in it,  
and there shall be no more utter  
destruction; but Jerusalem shall be  
safely inhabited.**
