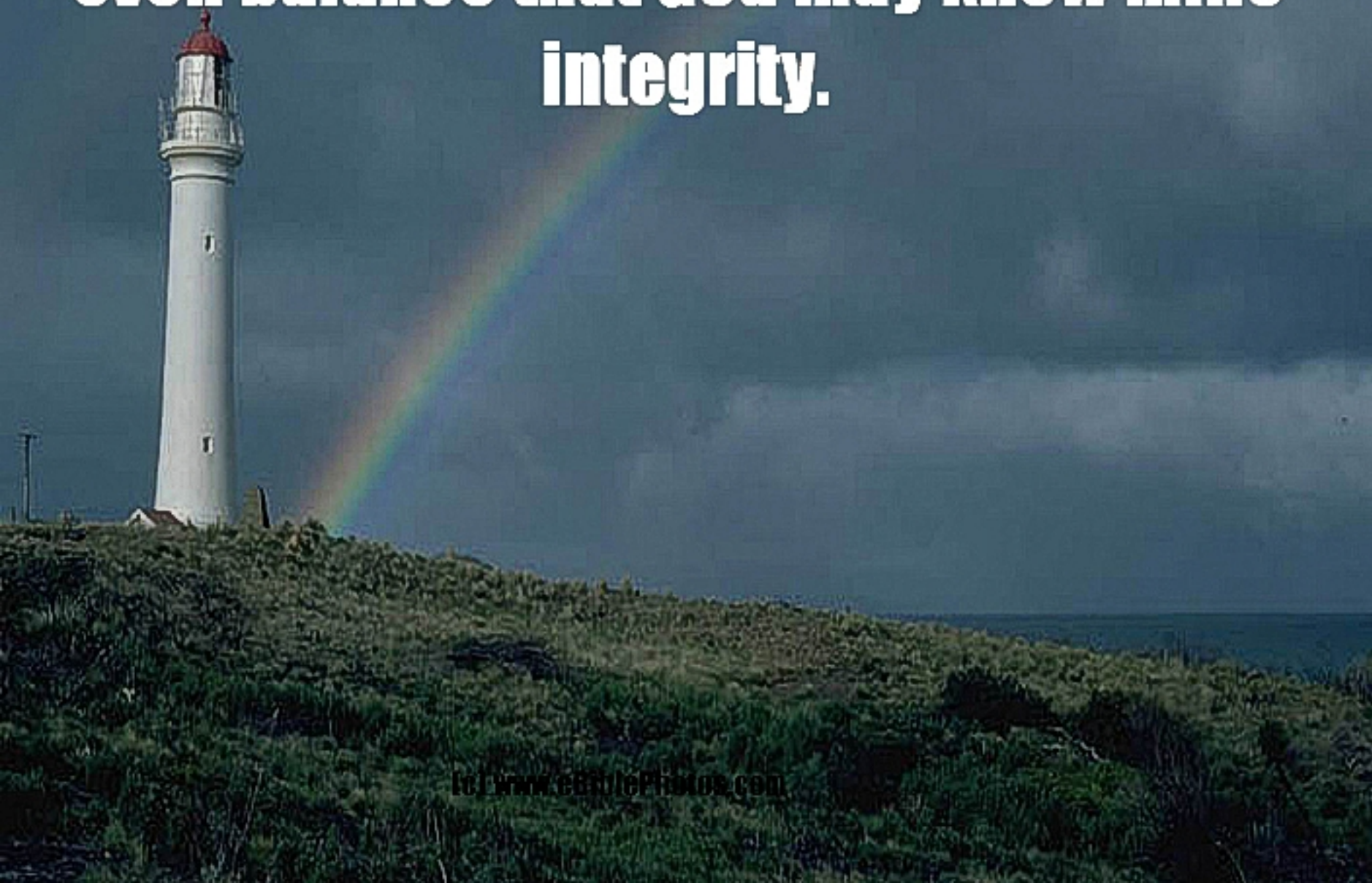


**Job 02:03 And the LORD said unto Satan,
