1Ki 22:50 And Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.

2Ki 01:17 So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken. And Jehoram reigned in his stead in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah; because he had no son.



**2Ki 03:01 Now Jehoram the son of Ahab
began to reign over Israel in Samaria
the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat
king of Judah, and reigned twelve
years.**

**2Ki 03:06 And king Jehoram went out
of Samaria the same time, and
numbered all Israel.**



**2Ki 08:16 And in the fifth year of Joram
the son of Ahab king of Israel,
Jehoshaphat [being] then king of
Judah, Jehoram the son of
Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to
reign.**

**2Ki 08:25 In the twelfth year of Joram
the son of Ahab king of Israel did
Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of
Judah begin to reign.**

**2Ki 08:29 And king Joram went back to
be healed in Jezreel of the wounds
which the Syrians had given him at
Ramah, when he fought against Hazael
king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of
Jehoram king of Judah went down to
see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel,
because he was sick.**

2Ki 09:24 And Jehu drew a bow with his full strength, and smote Jehoram between his arms, and the arrow went out at his heart, and he sunk down in his chariot.

2Ki 12:18 And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold that was found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent it to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

**2Ch 17:08 And with them [he sent]
Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and
Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel,
and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan,
and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and
Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them
Elishama and Jehoram, priests.**

2Ch 21:01 Now Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.

2Ch 21:03 And their father gave them great gifts of silver, and of gold, and of precious things, with fenced cities in Judah: but the kingdom gave he to Jehoram; because he [was] the firstborn.

2Ch 21:04 Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself, and slew all his brethren with the sword, and [divers] also of the princes of Israel.

**2Ch 21:05 Jehoram I wasl thirty and
two years old when he began to reign,
and he reigned eight years in
Jerusalem.**

**2Ch 21:09 Then Jehoram went forth
with his princes, and all his chariots
with him: and he rose up by night, and
smote the Edomites which compassed
him in, and the captains of the
chariots.**

2Ch 21:16 Moreover the LORD stirred up against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that I were] near the Ethiopians:

2Ch 22:01 And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

**2Ch 22:05 He walked also after their
counsel, and went with Jehoram the
son of Ahab king of Israel to war
against Hazael king of Syria at
Ramothgilead: and the Syrians smote
Joram.**

**2Ch 22:06 And he returned to be healed
in Jezreel because of the wounds which
were given him at Ramah, when he
fought with Hazael king of Syria. And
Azariah the son of Jehoram king of
Judah went down to see Jehoram the
son of Ahab at Jezreel, because he was
sick.**

**2Ch 22:07 And the destruction of
Ahaziah was of God by coming to
Joram: for when he was come, he went
out with Jehoram against Jehu the son
of Nimshi, whom the LORD had
anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.**

2Ch 22:11B Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the King, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the King's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.
