


**Jos 15:44 And Keilah, and Achzib, and


1Sa 23:03 And David's men said unto him, Behold, we be afraid here in Judah: how much more then if we come to Keilah against the armies of the Philistines?





1Sa 23:08 And Saul called all the people together to war, to go down to Keilah, to besiege David and his men.


