




Num 35:04 And the suburbs of the cities, which ye shall give unto the Levites, [shall reach] from the wall of the city and outward a thousand cubits round about.



and the going up to it [had] eight steps.**




Eze 44:01 Then he brought me back the way of the gate of the outward sanctuary which looketh toward the east; and it [was] shut.
