



**Exo 23:21 Beware of him, and obey his
voice, provoke him not; for he will not
pardon your transgressions, for my
name is in him.**

Exo 34:09 And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it [is] a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance.

**Num 14:19 Pardon, I beseech thee, the
iniquity of this people according unto
the greatness of thy mercy, and as
thou hast forgiven this people from
Egypt even until now.**

**1Sa 15:25 Now therefore, I pray thee,
pardon my sin, and turn again with me,
that I may worship the LORD.**


**Psa 25:11 For thy name's sake, O LORD,
