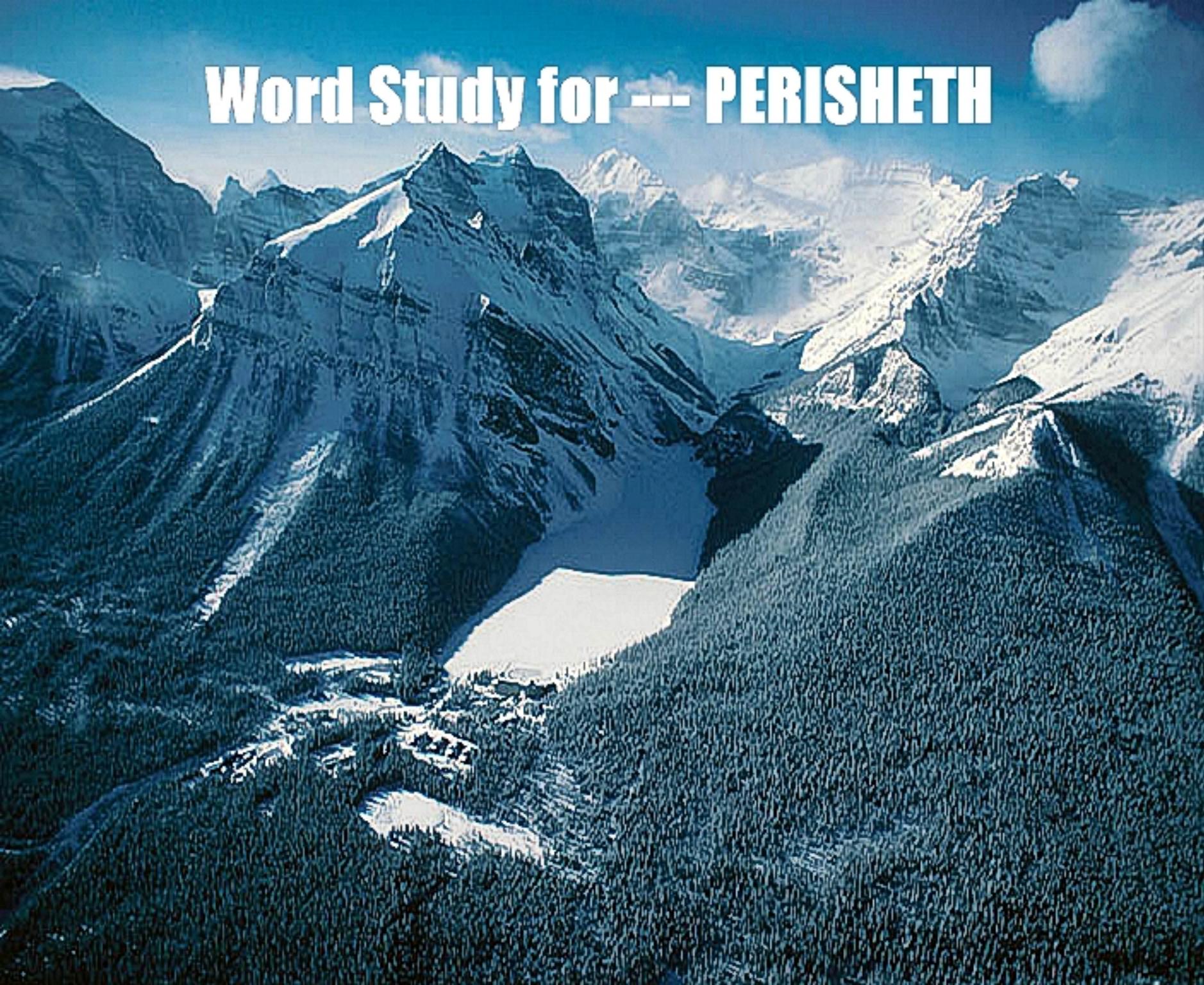


**Job 04:11 The old lion perisheth for

Pro 11:07 When a wicked man dieth, [his] expectation shall perish: and the hope of unjust [men] perisheth.


**Ecc 07:15 All [things] have I seen in the


