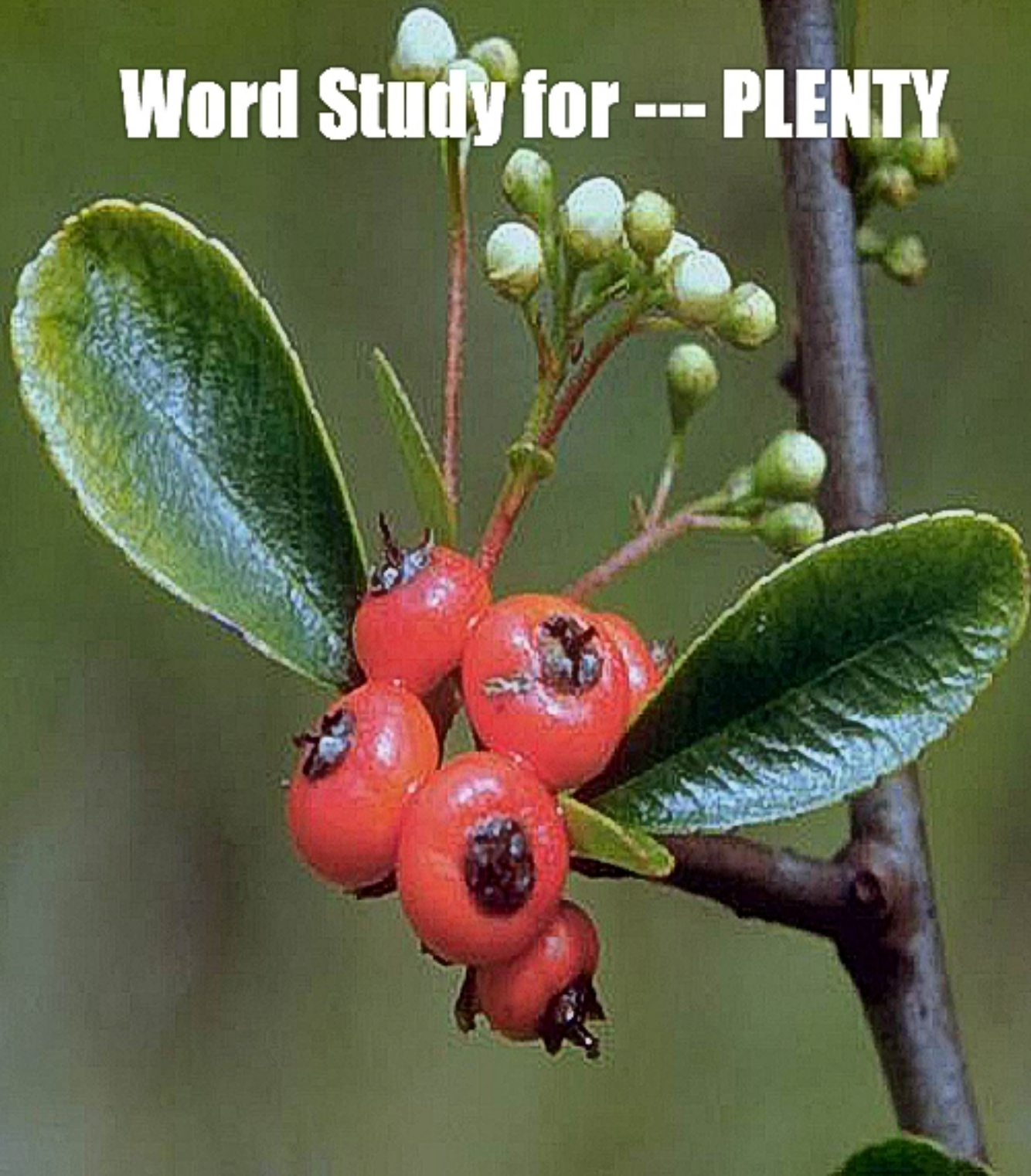

land of Egypt:**




**Gen 41:30 And there shall arise after




