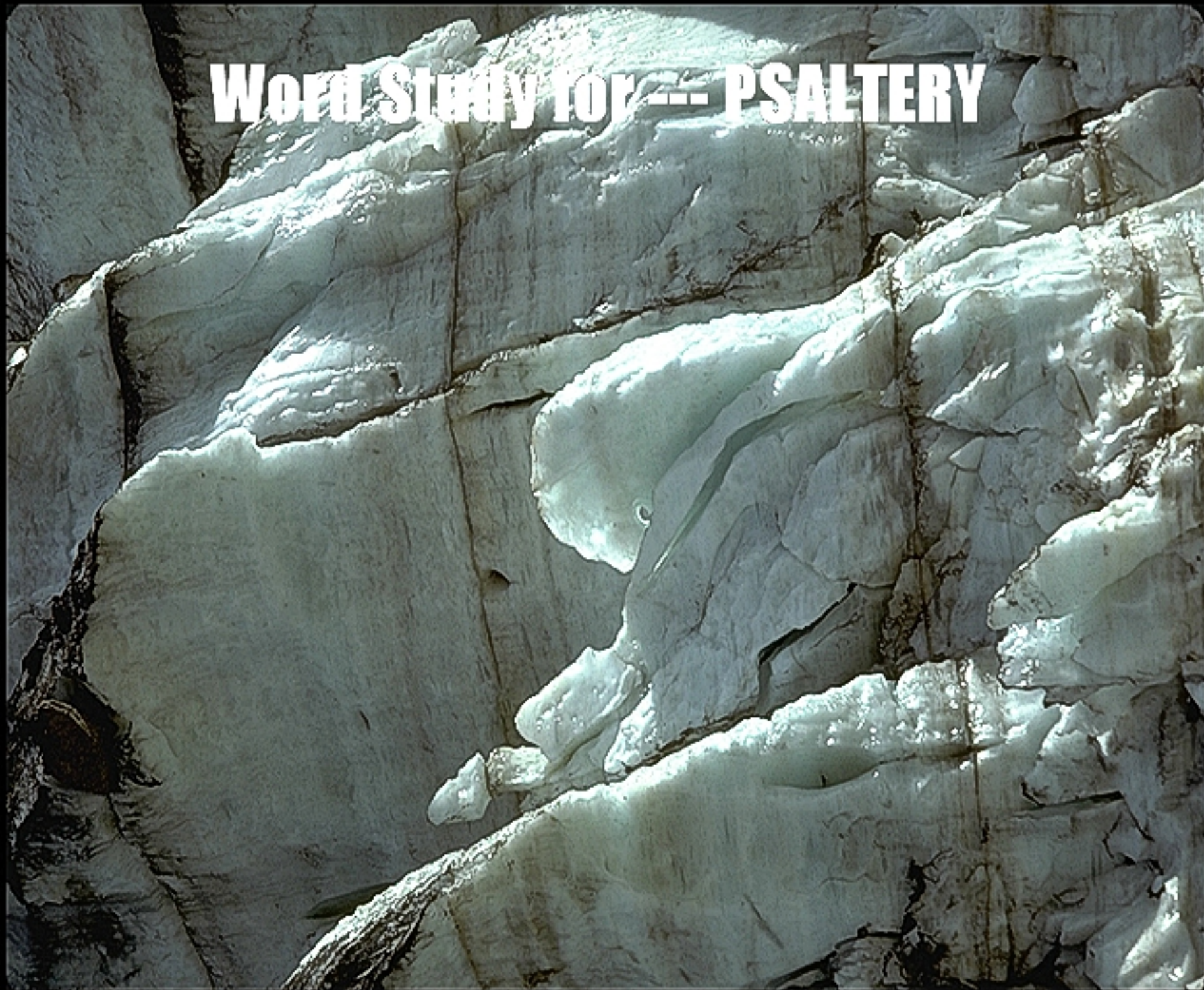






awake early.**



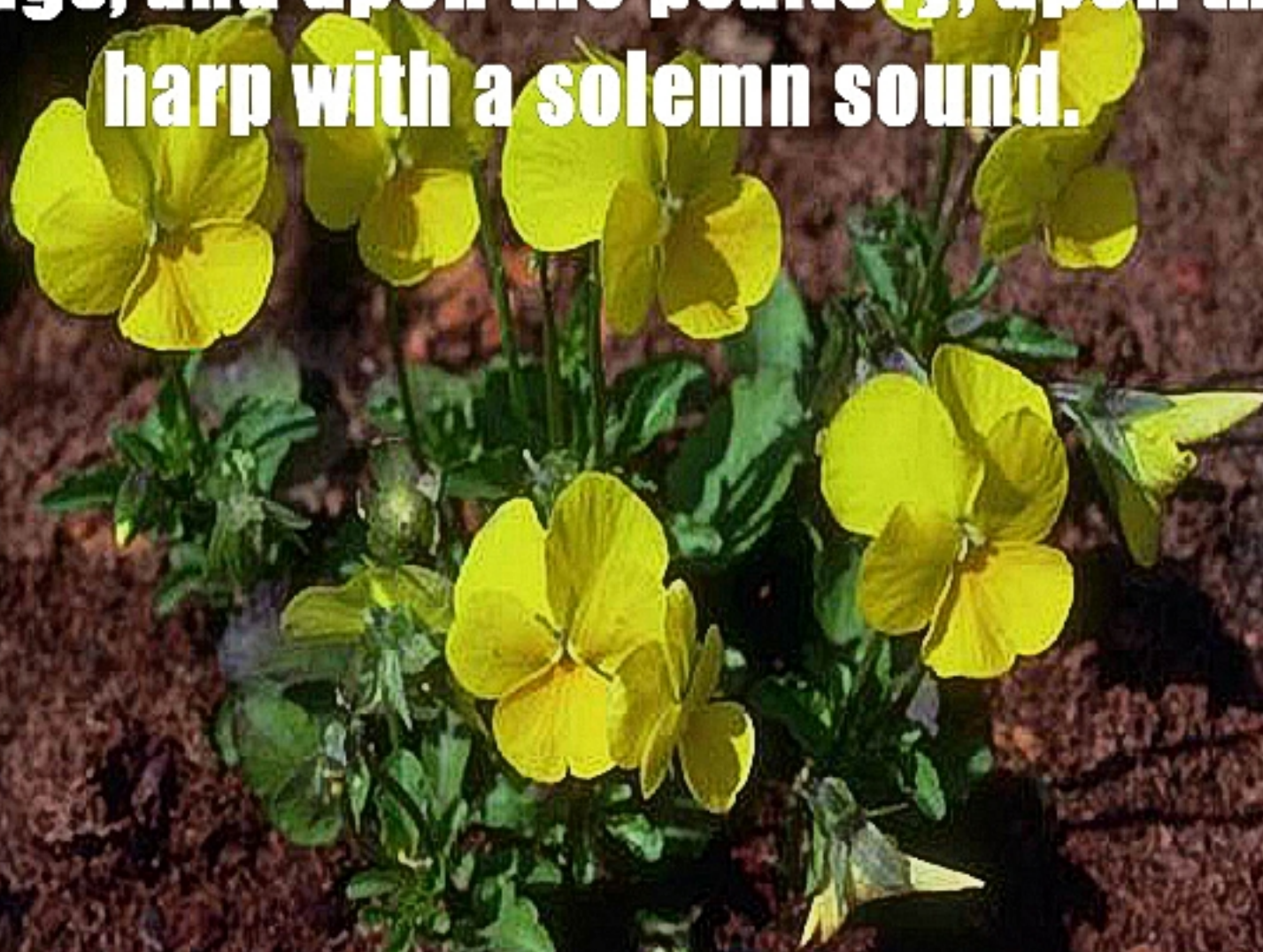
**Psa 71:22 I will also praise thee with

with the psaltery.**

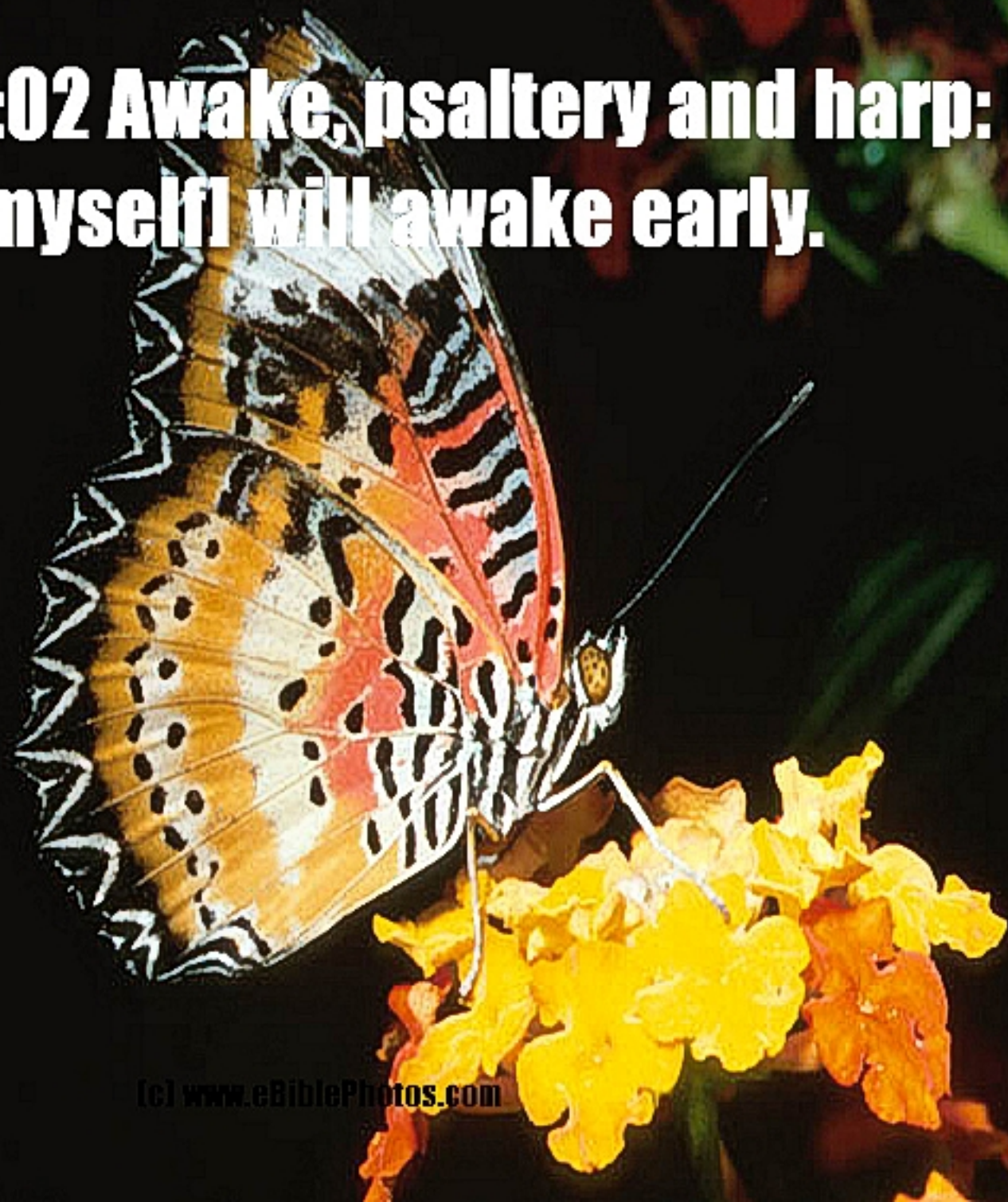


**Psa 92:03 Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound.**

**Psa 144:09 I will sing a new song unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery and an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee.**




**Psa 150:03 Praise him with the sound
