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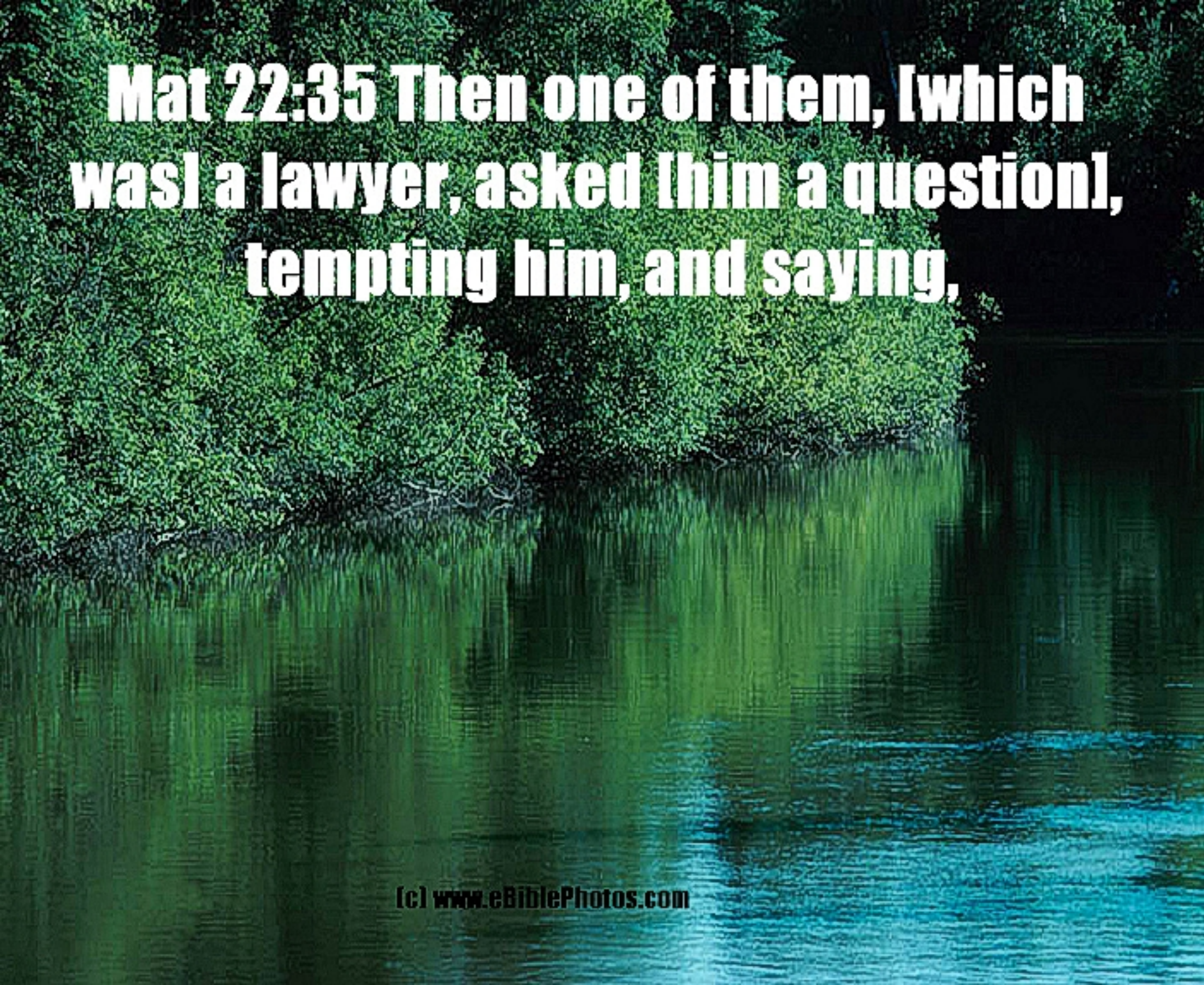




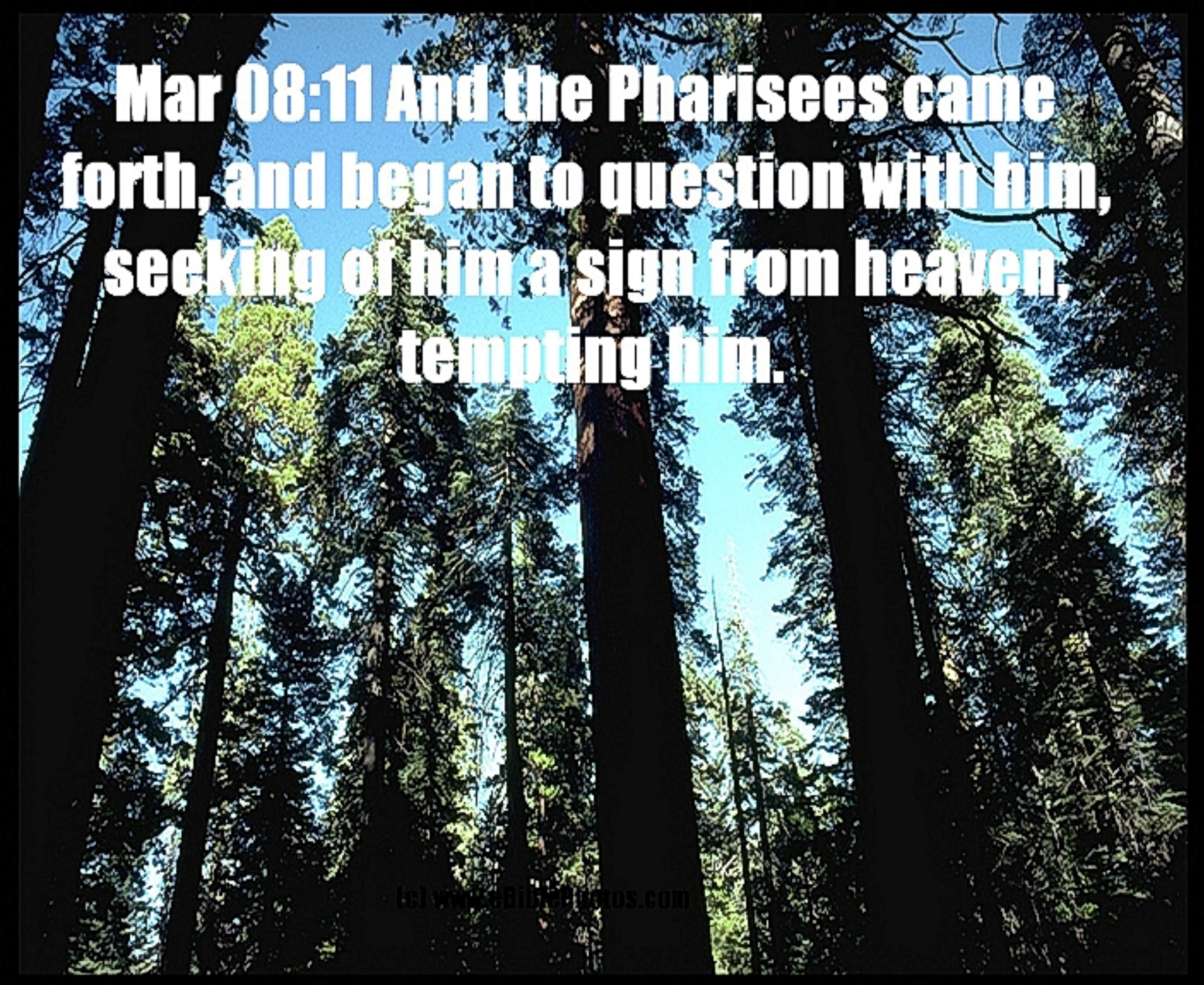

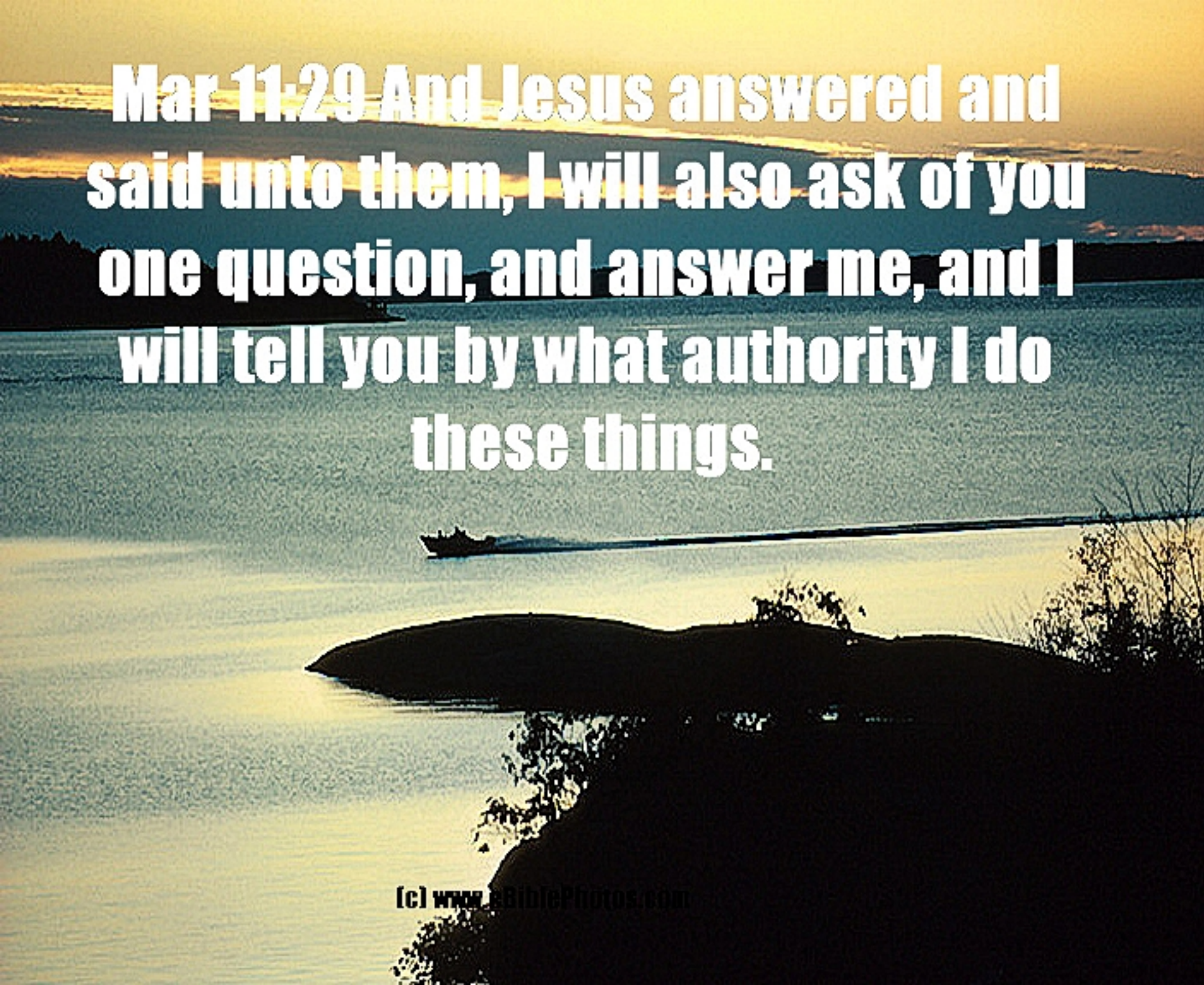


**Mat 22:35 Then one of them, [which

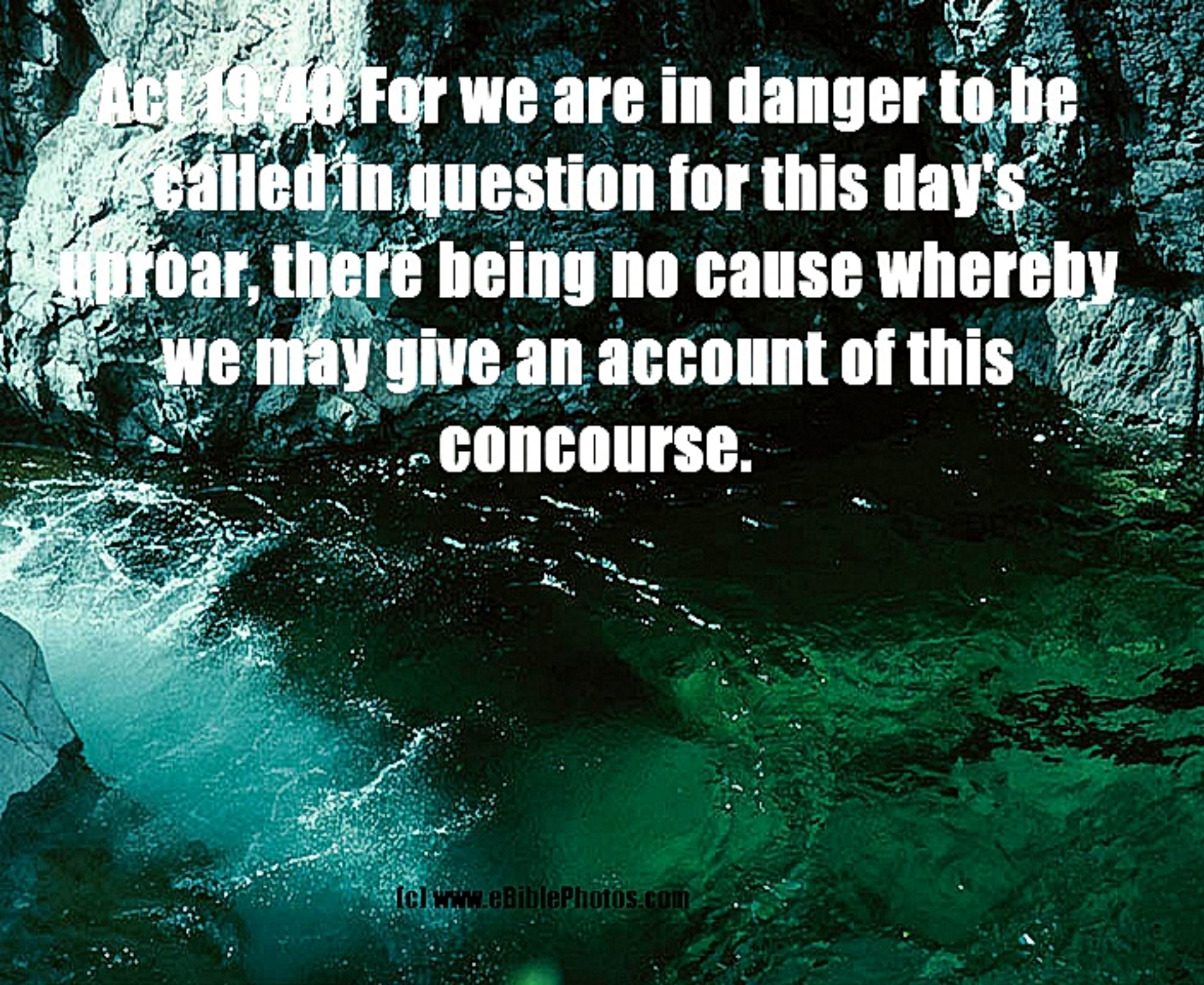
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**Luk 20:40 And after that they durst not

Act 18:15 But if it be a question of words and names, and [of] your law, look ye [to it]; for I will be no judge of such [matters].

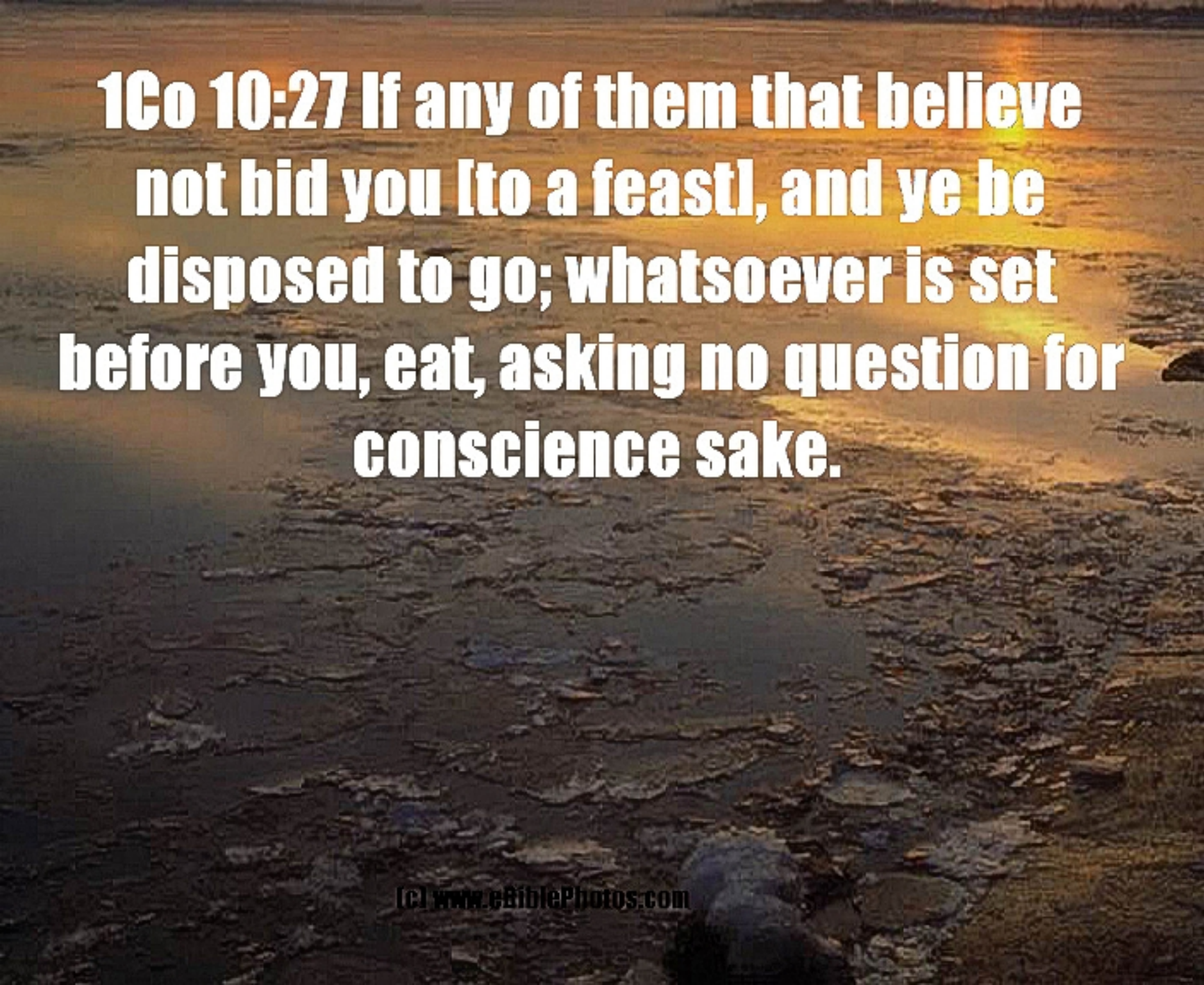
