

# Word Study for --- RABSHAKEH



**2Ki 18:17 And the king of Assyria sent  
Tartan and Rabsaris and Rabshakeh  
from Lachish to king Hezekiah with a  
great host against Jerusalem. And  
they went up and came to Jerusalem.  
And when they were come up, they  
came and stood by the conduit of the  
upper pool, which [is] in the highway  
of the fuller's field.**

**2Ki 18:19 And Rabshakeh said unto them, Speak ye now to Hezekiah, Thus saith the great king, the king of Assyria, What confidence [is] this wherein thou trustest?**



**2KI 18:26 Then said Eliakim the son of  
Hilkiah, and Shebnā, and Joah, unto  
Rabshakeh, Speak I pray thee, to thy  
servants in the Syrian language; for  
we understand it not: and talk not with  
us in the Jews' language in the ears of  
the people that larel on the wall.**

**2Ki 18:27 But Rabshakeh said unto them, Hath my master sent me to thy master, and to thee, to speak these words? I hath he not [sent me] to the men which sit on the wall, that they may eat their own dung, and drink their own piss with you?**
