

# **Word Study for --- RIBLAH**

**Num 34:11 And the coast shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach unto the side of the sea of Chinnereth eastward:**

**2Ki 23:33 And Pharaohnechoh put him  
in bands at Riblah in the land of  
Hamath, that he might not reign in  
Jerusalem; and put the land to a  
tribute of an hundred talents of silver,  
and a talent of gold.**

**2Ki 25:06 So they took the king, and  
brought him up to the king of Babylon  
to Riblah; and they gave judgment  
upon him.**

**2Ki 25:20 And Nebuzaradan captain of  
the guard took these, and brought them  
to the king of Babylon to Riblah:**

**2Ki 25:21 And the king of Babylon smote them, and slew them at Riblah in the land of Hamath. So Judah was carried away out of their land.**

**Jer 39:05 But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him.**

**Jer 39:06 Then the king of Babylon  
slew the sons of Zedekiah in Riblah  
before his eyes: also the king of  
Babylon slew all the nobles of Judah.**

**Jer 52:09 Then they took the king; and,  
carried him up unto the king of  
Babylon to Riblah in the land of  
Hamath; where he gave judgment  
upon him.**

**Jer 52:10 And the king of Babylon slew  
the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes:  
he slew also all the princes of Judah  
in Riblah.**

**Jer 52:26 So Nebuzaradan the captain  
of the guard took them, and brought  
them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.**

**Jer 52:27 And the king of Babylon smote them, and put them to death in Riblah in the land of Hamath. Thus Judah was carried away captive out of his own land.**
