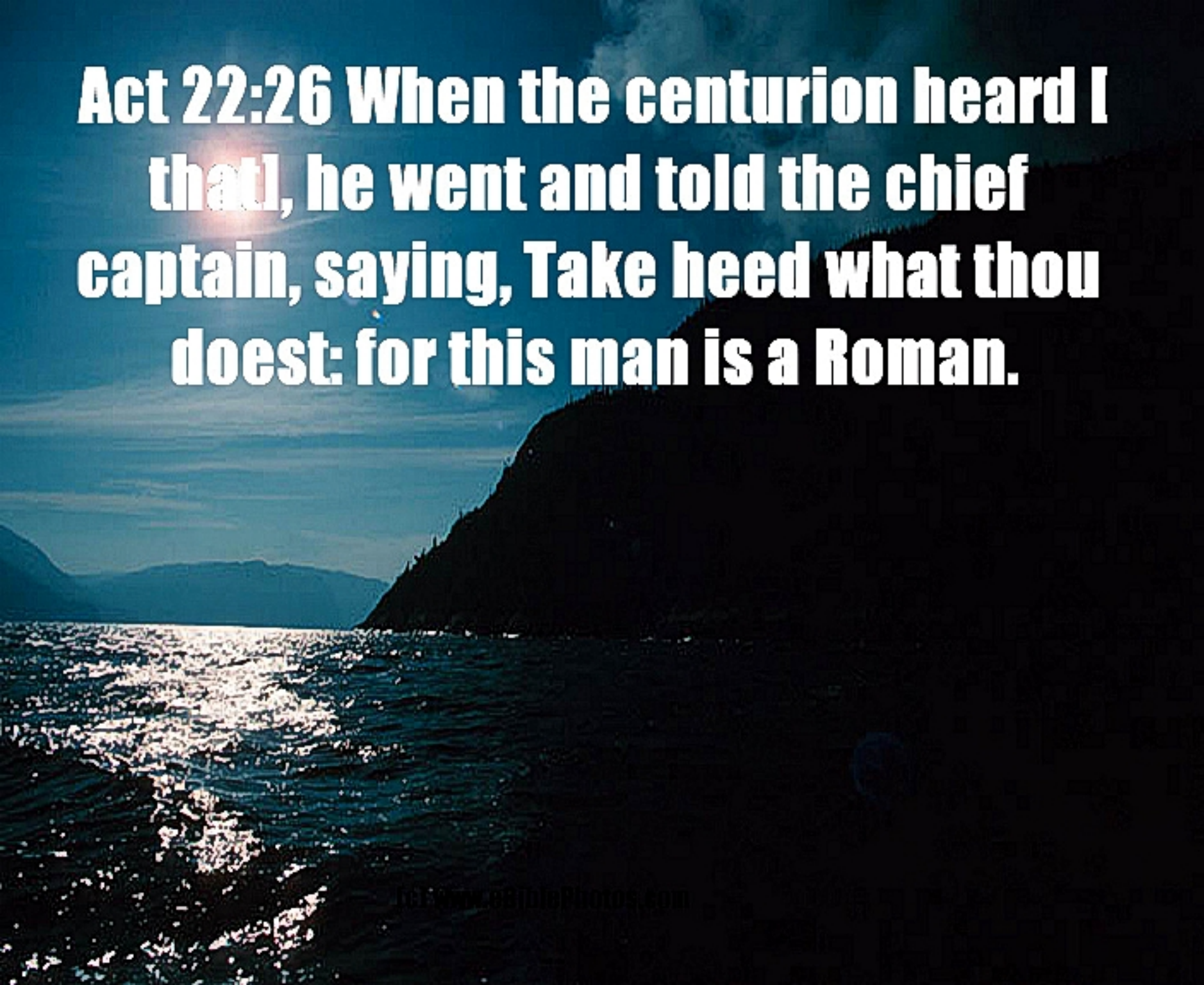

uncondemned?**


**Act 22:26 When the centurion heard I
