




Word Study for --- RAZOR




Num 06:05 All the days of the vow of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth [himself] unto the LORD, he shall be holy, [and] shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.

of the hand of the Philistines.**




**Jud 16:17 That he told her all his heart,
