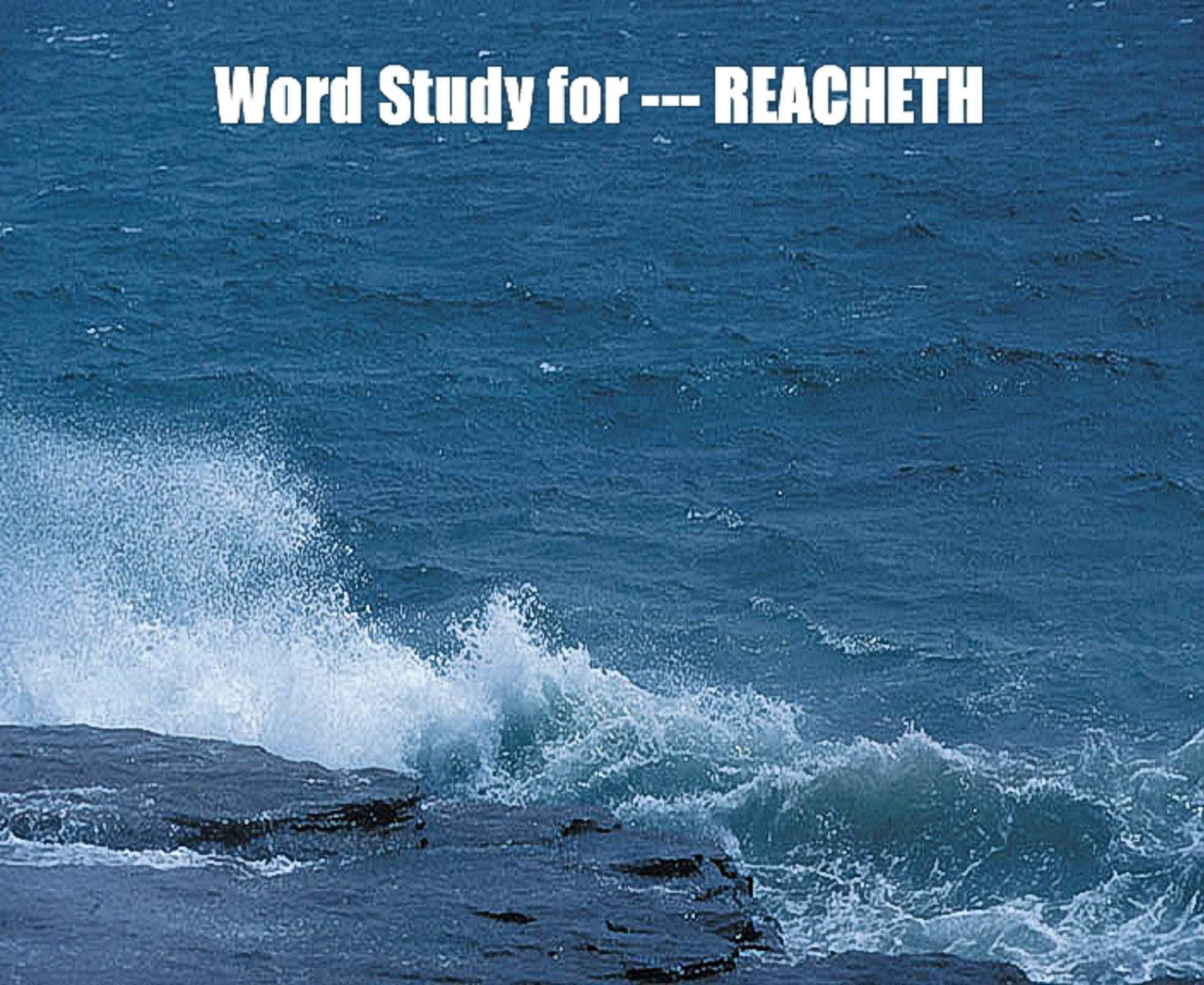




**Num 21:30 We have shot at them;


