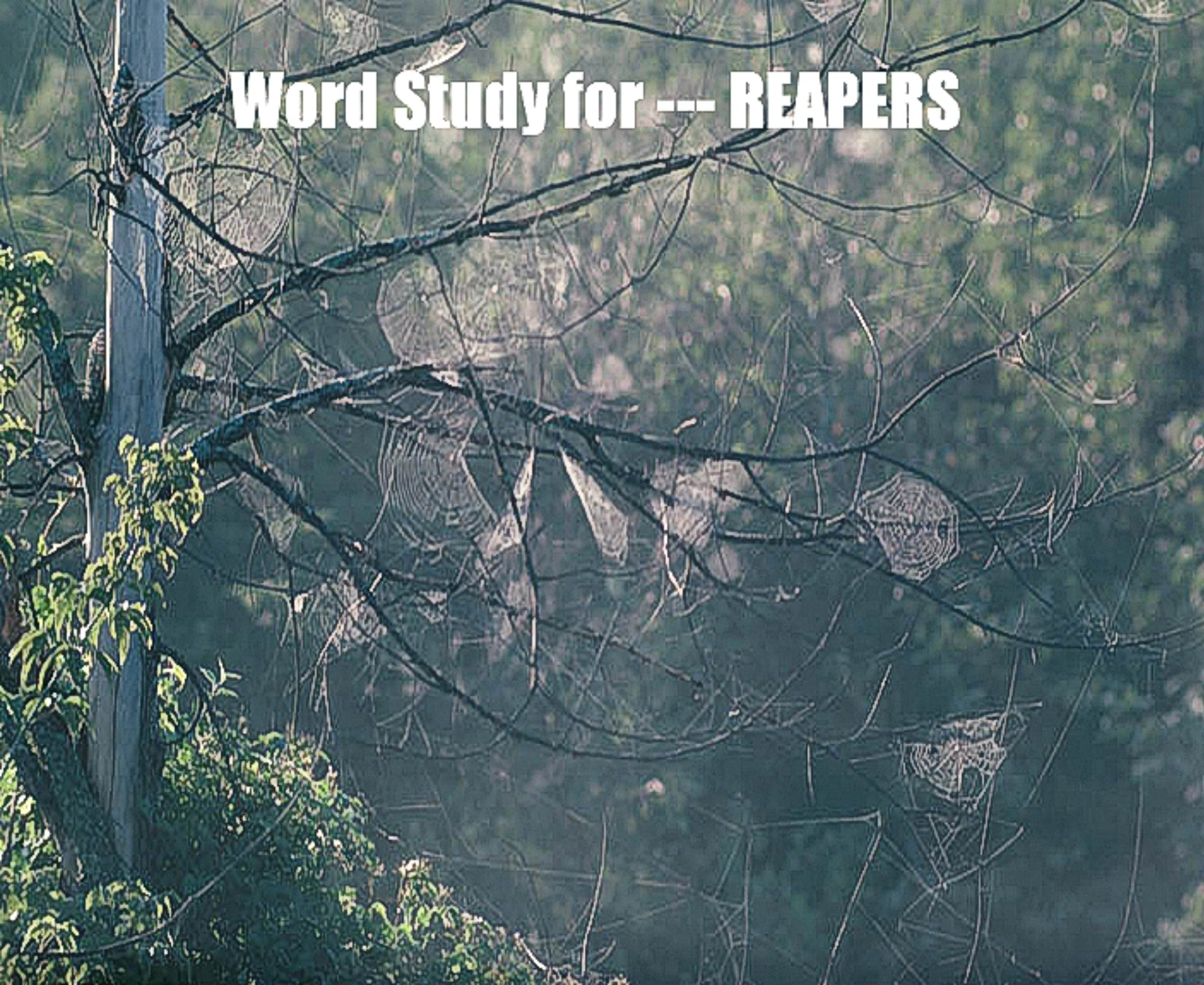



Moab:**


