

# Word Study for — RECOVER

**Jud 11:26 While Israel dwelt in Heshbon and her towns, and in Aroer and her towns, and in all the cities that [bel] along by the coasts of Arnon, three hundred years? why therefore did ye not recover [them] within that time?**

**1Sa 30:08 And David inquired at the  
LORD, saying, Shall I pursue after this  
troop? shall I overtake them? And he  
answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt  
surely overtake [them], and without  
fail recover [all].**

**2Sa 08:03 David smote also Hadadezer, the son of Rehob, king of Zobah, as he went to recover his border at the river Euphrates.**

**2Ki 01:02 And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that [was] in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, inquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.**

seeketh a quarrel against me.**



shouldst surely recover.**




**2Ch 13:20 Neither did Jeroboam recover strength again in the days of Abijah: and the LORD struck him, and he died.**

and be no more.**


**Isa 11:11 And it shall come to pass in
