

Word Study for --- REED

1Ki 14:15 For the LORD shall smite Israel, as a reed is shaken in the water, and he shall root up Israel out of this good land, which he gave to their fathers, and shall scatter them beyond the river, because they have made their groves, provoking the LORD to anger.

2Ki 18:21 Now, behold, thou trustest upon the staff of this bruised reed, [even] upon Egypt, on which if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt unto all that trust on him.

**Job 40:21 He lieth under the shady
trees, in the covert of the reed, and fens.**

**Isa 36:06 Lo, thou trustest in the staff of
this broken reed, on Egypt; whereon if a
man lean, it will go into his hand, and
pierce it: so is Pharaoh king of Egypt to
all that trust in him.**

Isa 42:03 A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.

Eze 29:06 And all the inhabitants of Egypt shall know that I [am] the LORD, because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel.

**Eze 40:03 And he brought me thither,
and, behold, [there was] a man, whose
appearance [was] like the appearance
of brass, with a line of flax in his hand,
and a measuring reed; and he stood in
the gate.**

Eze 40:05 And behold a wall on the outside of the house round about, and in the man's hand a measuring reed of six cubits [long] by the cubit and an hand breadth: so he measured the breadth of the building, one reed; and the height, one reed.

**Eze 40:06 Then came he unto the gate
which looketh toward the east, and
went up the stairs thereof, and
measured the threshold of the gate, I
which wasl one reed broad; and the
other threshold lof the gate, which
wasl one reed broad.**

**Eze 40:07 And [every] little chamber I
was] one reed long, and one reed
broad; and between the little
chambers [were] five cubits: and the
threshold of the gate by the porch of
the gate within I was] one reed.**

**Eze 40:08 He measured also the porch
of the gate within, one reed.**




**Eze 41:08 I saw also the height of the
house round about: the foundations of
the side chambers [were] a full reed
of six great cubits.**

**Eze 42:16 He measured the east side
with the measuring reed, five hundred
reeds, with the measuring reed round
about.**

**Eze 42:17 He measured the north side,
five hundred reeds, with the measuring
reed round about.**




**Eze 42:18 He measured the south side,
five hundred reeds, with the
measuring reed.**



Eze 42:19 He turned about to the west side, [and] measured five hundred reeds with the measuring reed.

Mat 11:07 And as they departed, Jesus began to say unto the multitudes concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken with the wind?



Mat 12:20 A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.

Mat 27:29 And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put [it] upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!

Mat 27:30 And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.

Mat 27:48 And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled [it] with vinegar, and put [it] on a reed, and gave him to drink.

Mar 15:19 And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing [their] knees worshipped him.

Mar 15:36 And one ran and filled a sponge full of vinegar, and put [it] on a reed, and gave him to drink, saying, Let alone; let us see whether Elias will come to take him down.

Luk 07:24 And when the messengers of John were departed, he began to speak unto the people concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness for to see? A reed shaken with the wind?

Rev 11:01 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

**Rev 21:15 And he that talked with me
had a golden reed to measure the city,
and the gates thereof, and the wall
thereof.**

**Rev 21:16 And the city lieth foursquare,
and the length is as large as the
breadth: and he measured the city
with the reed, twelve thousand
furlongs. The length and the breadth
and the height of it are equal.**
