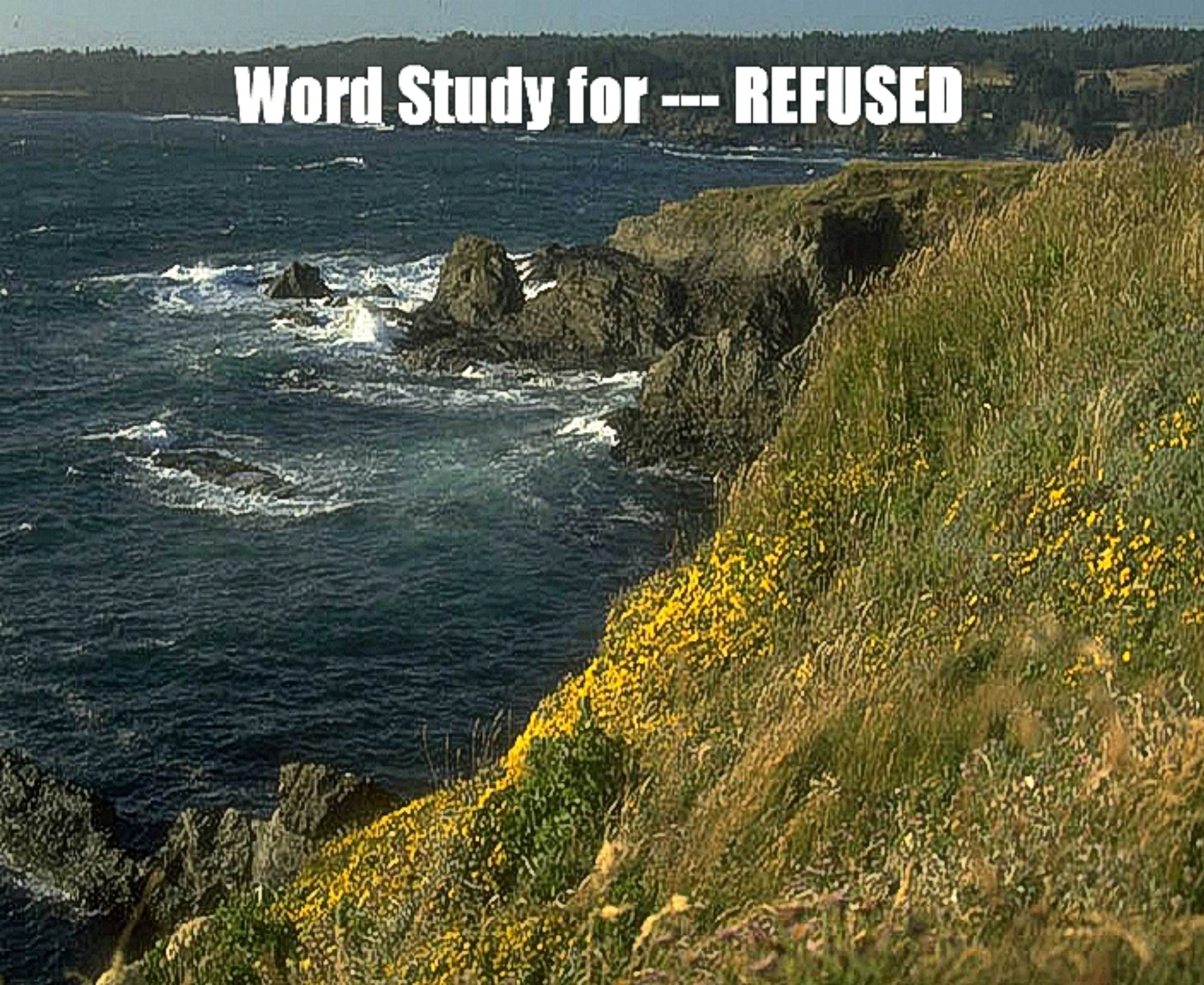





he hath to my hand;**





him.**




**Isa 54:06 For the LORD hath called thee



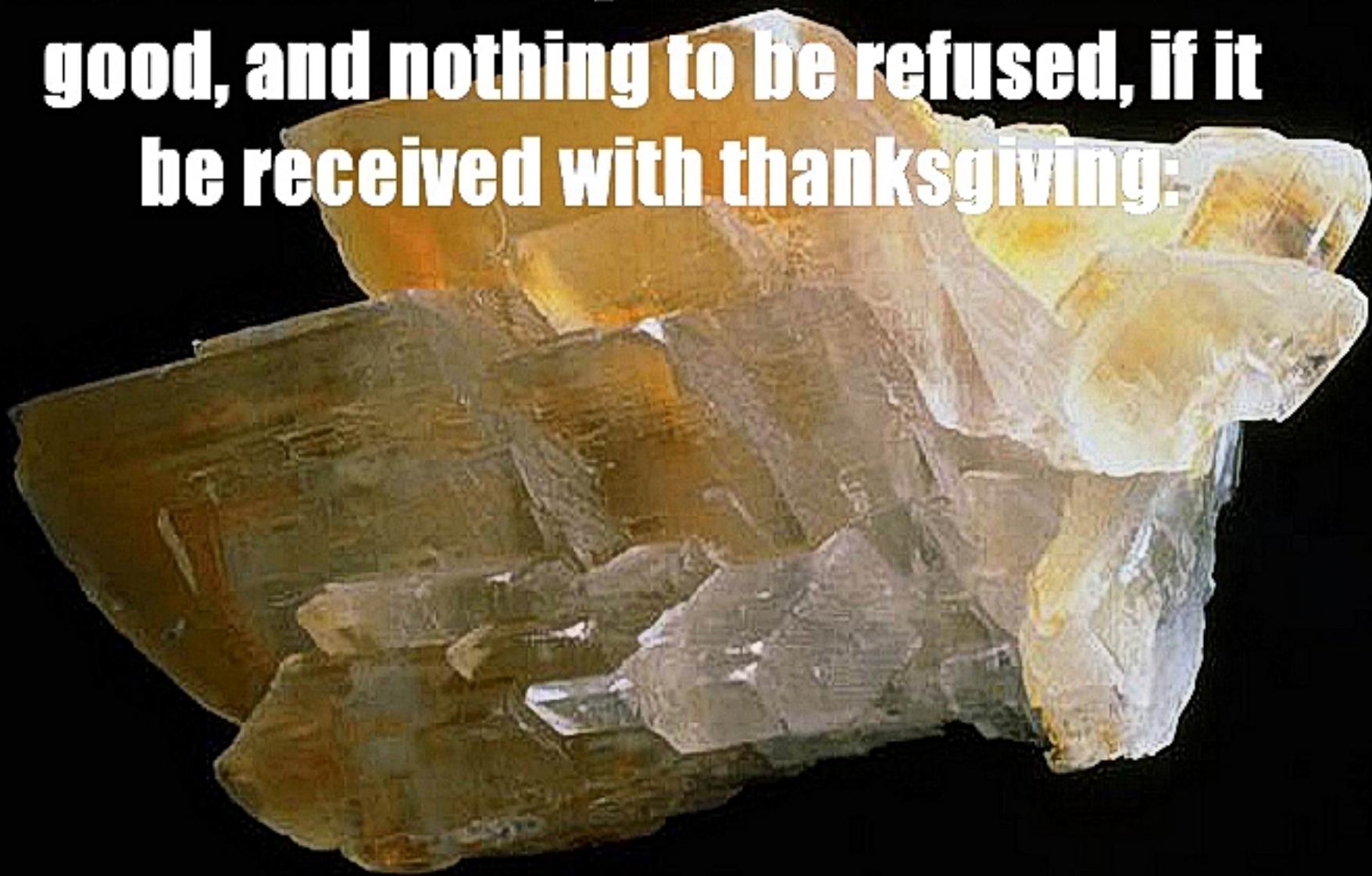


