**1Sa 08:07 And the LORD said unto
Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the
people in all that they say unto thee:
for they have not rejected thee, but
they have rejected me, that I should
not reign over them.**

**1Sa 10:19 And ye have this day rejected
your God, who himself saved you out of
all your adversities and your
tribulations; and ye have said unto him,
Nay , but set a king over us. Now
therefore present yourselves before
the LORD by your tribes, and by your
thousands.**

**1Sa 15:23 For rebellion [is as] the sin
of witchcraft, and stubbornness [is as]
iniquity and idolatry. Because thou
hast rejected the word of the LORD, he
hath also rejected thee from [being]
king.**


2Ki 17:20 And the LORD rejected all the seed of Israel, and afflicted them, and delivered them into the hand of spoilers, until he had cast them out of his sight

trouble!**


**Lam 05:22 But thou hast utterly

again.**


Mar 12:10 And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner:
