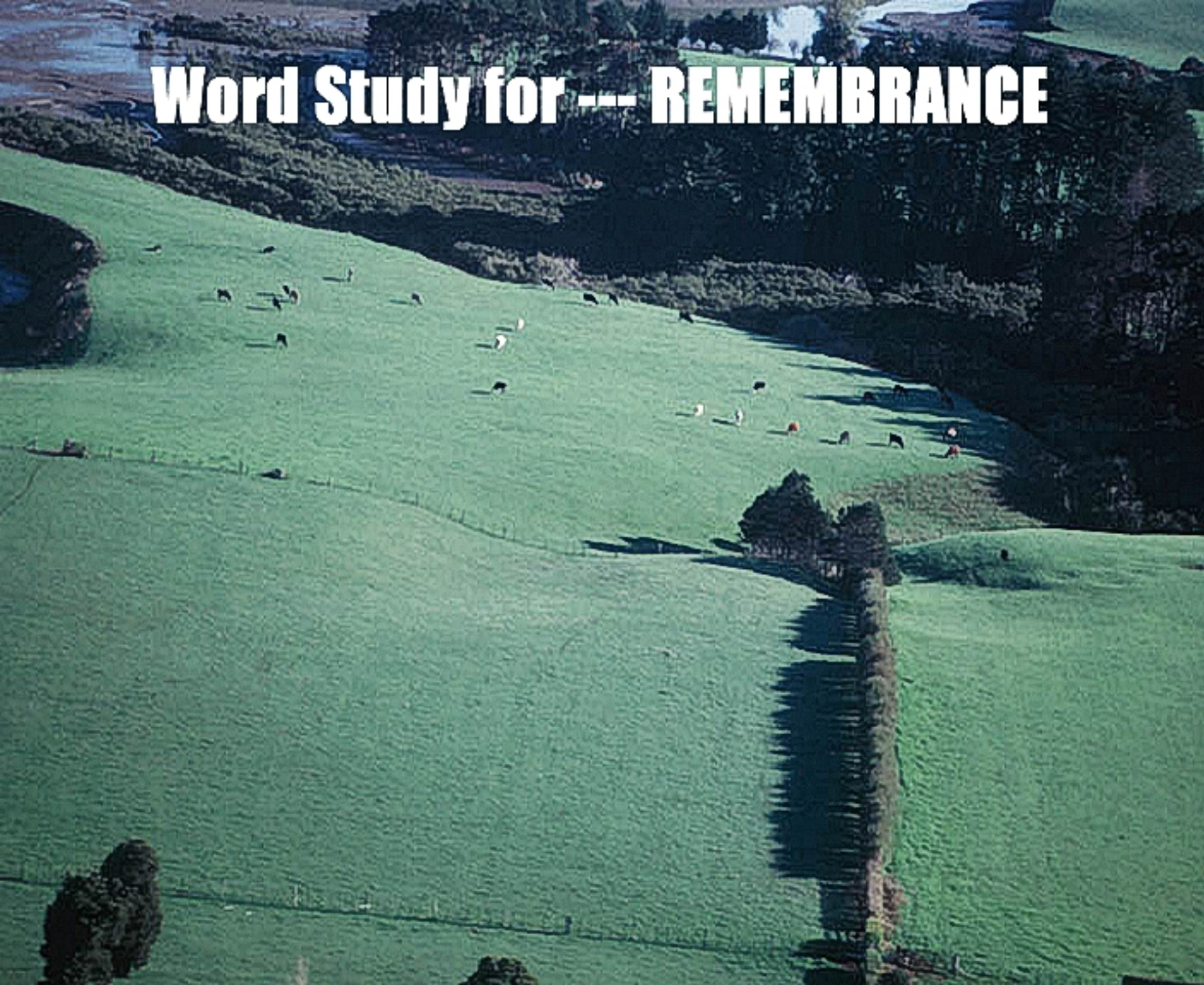





heaven.**




