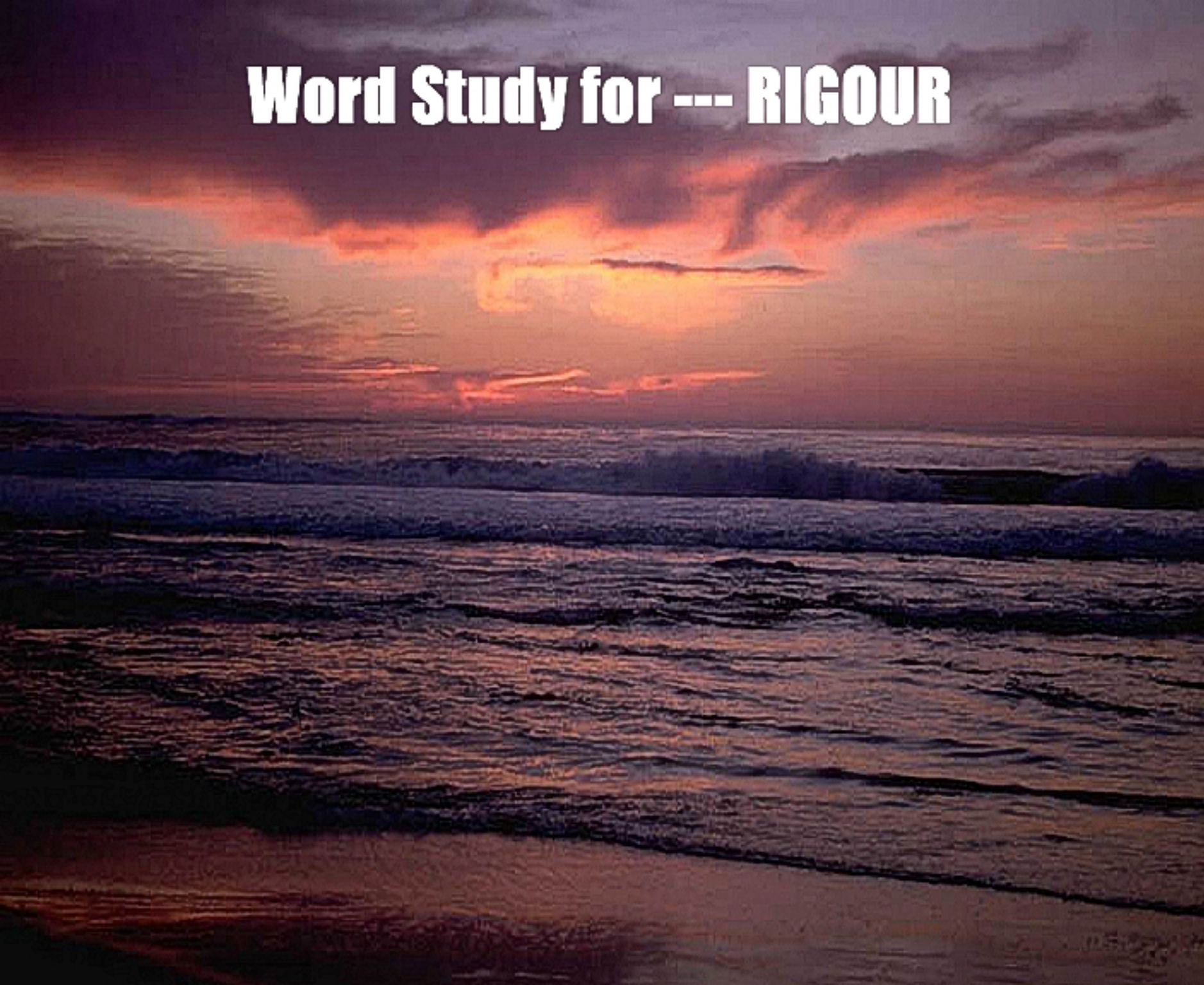


Exo 01:13 And the Egyptians made the children of Israel to serve with rigour:
