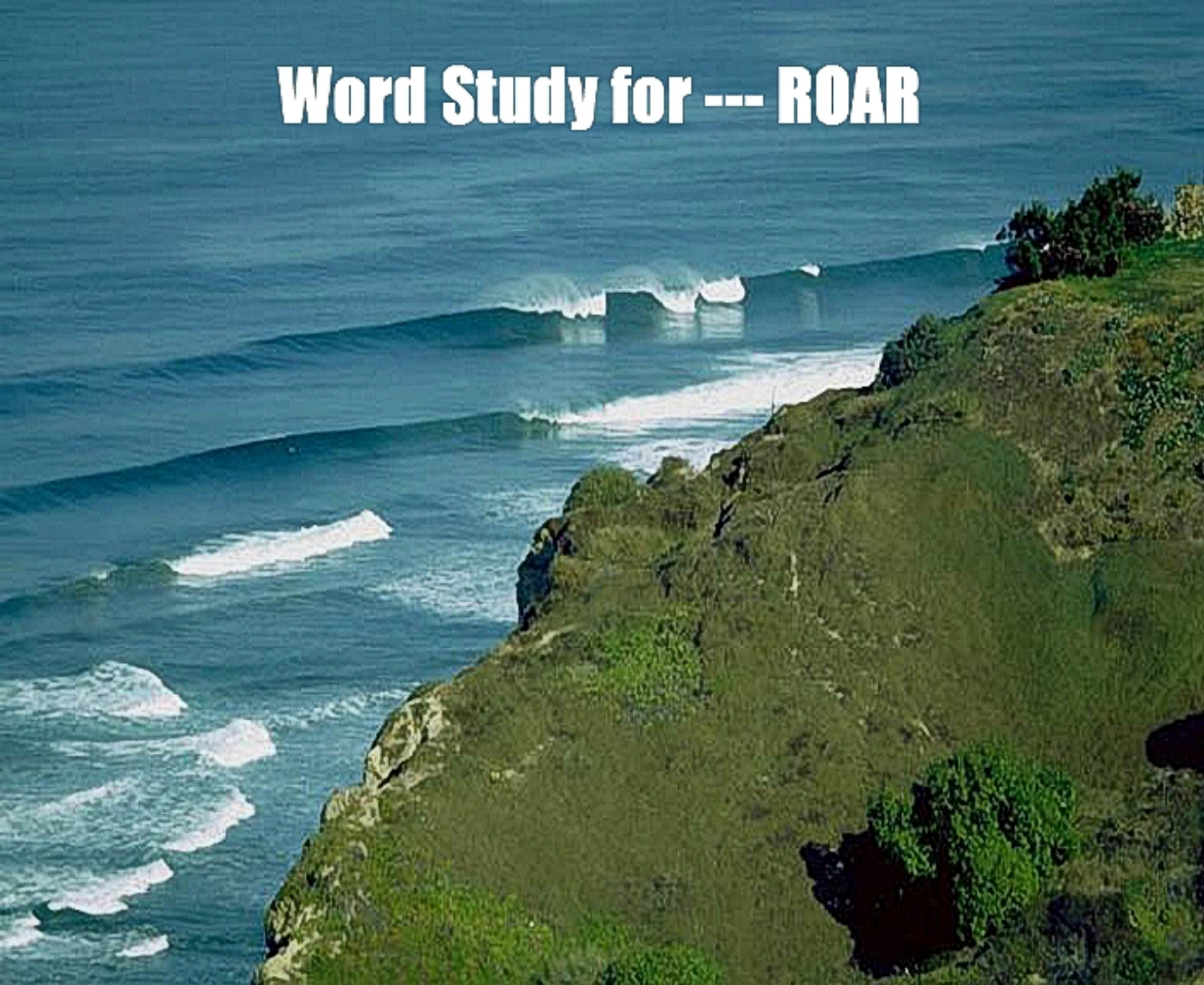



and all that [is] therein.**

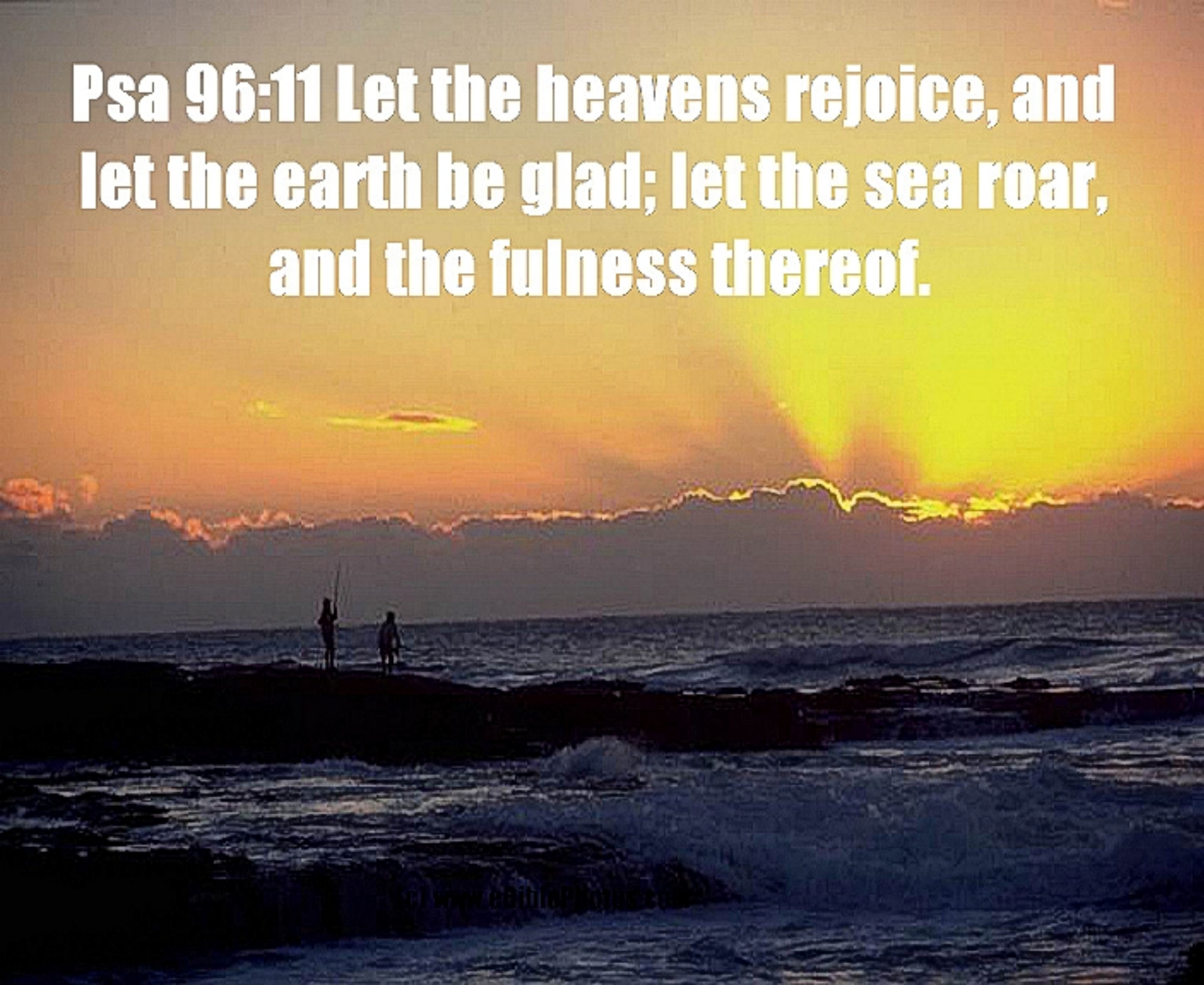
