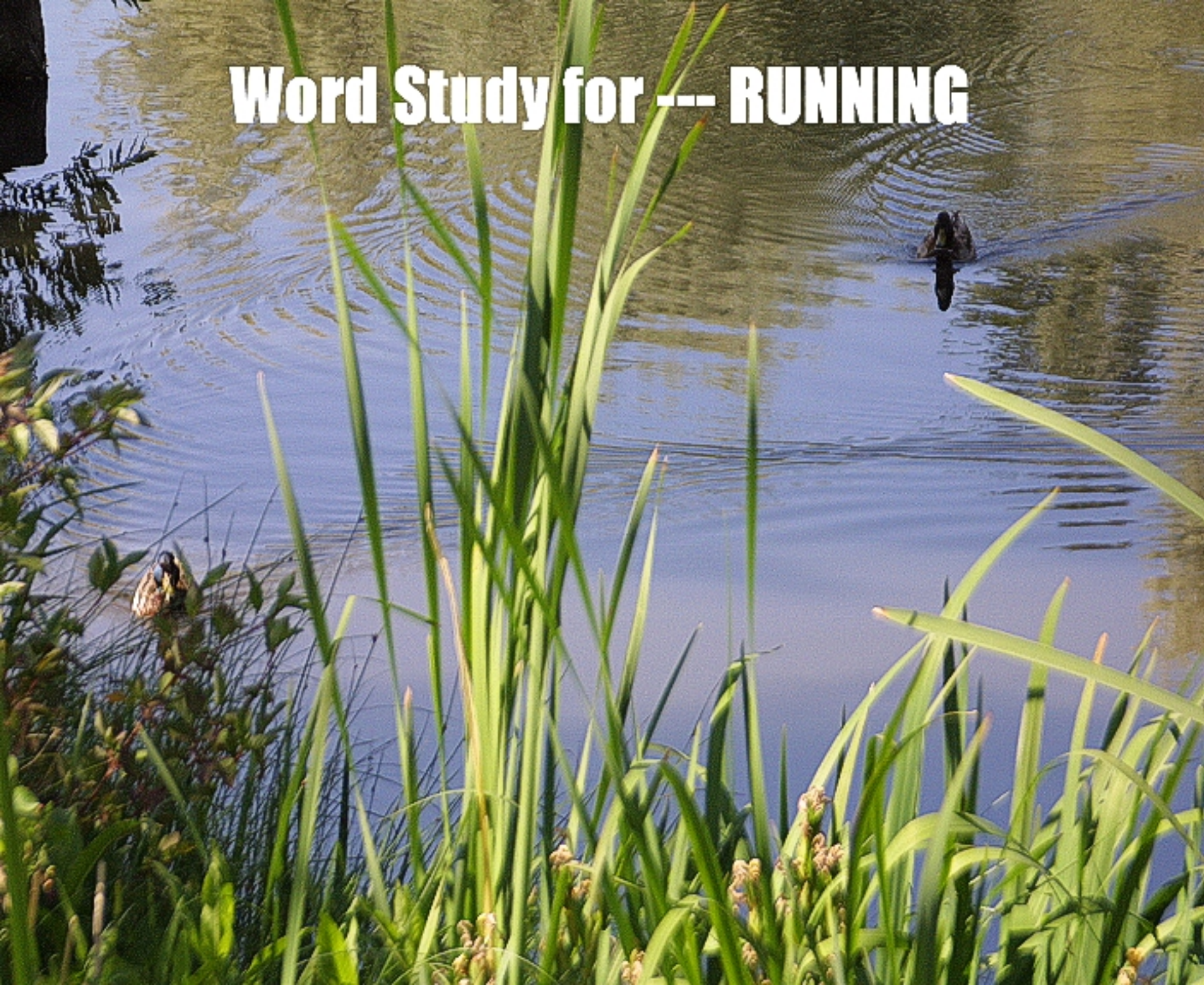






**Lev 14:50 And he shall kill the one of

running water:**



Lev 15:02 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When any man hath a running issue out of his flesh, [because of] his issue he [is] unclean.


