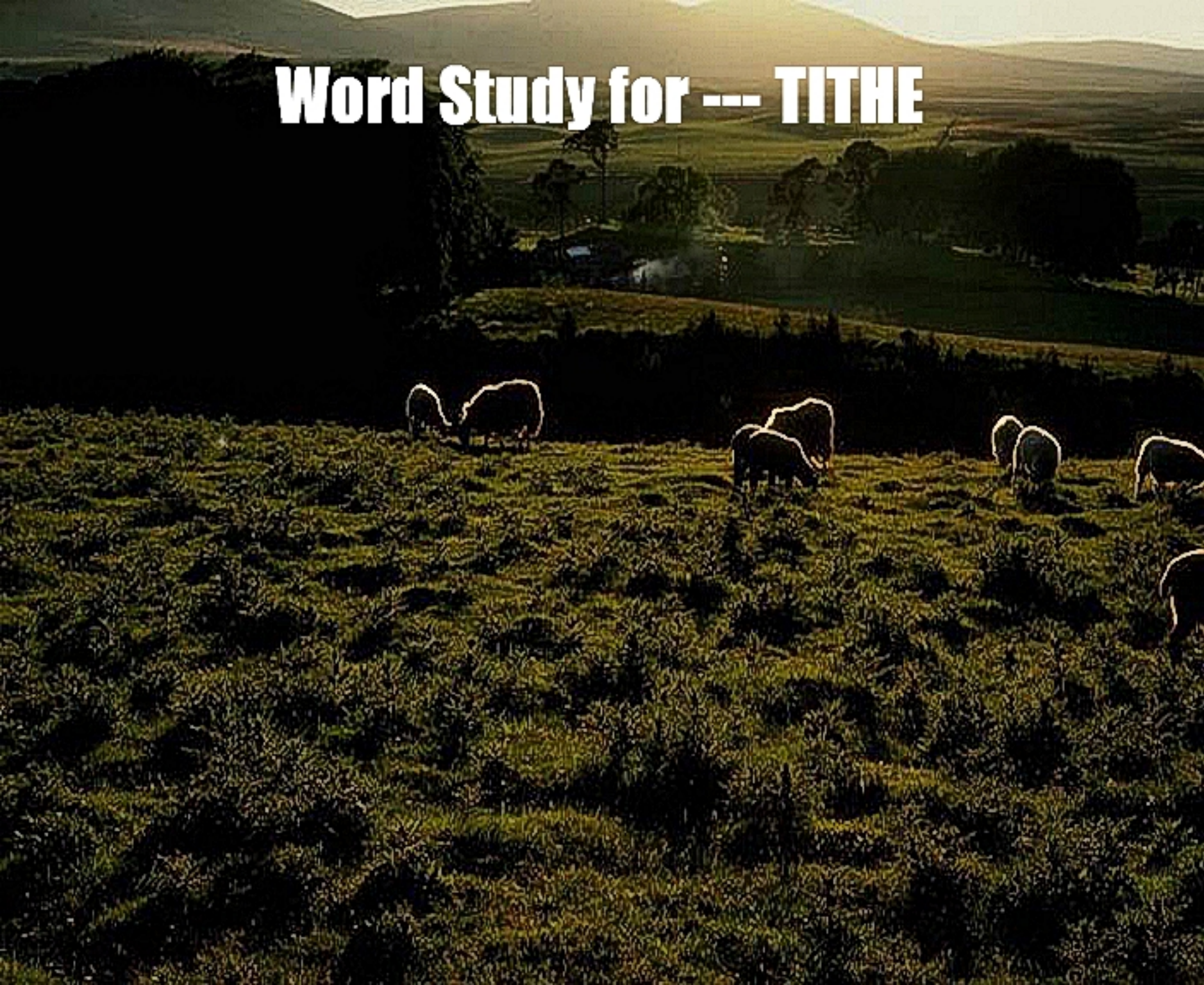




**Lev 27:30 And all the tithe of the land, I


**Lev 27:32 And concerning the tithe of






**Deu 14:22 Thou shalt truly tithe all the




**Deu 14:28 At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates:**




**Neh 10:38 And the priest the son of
