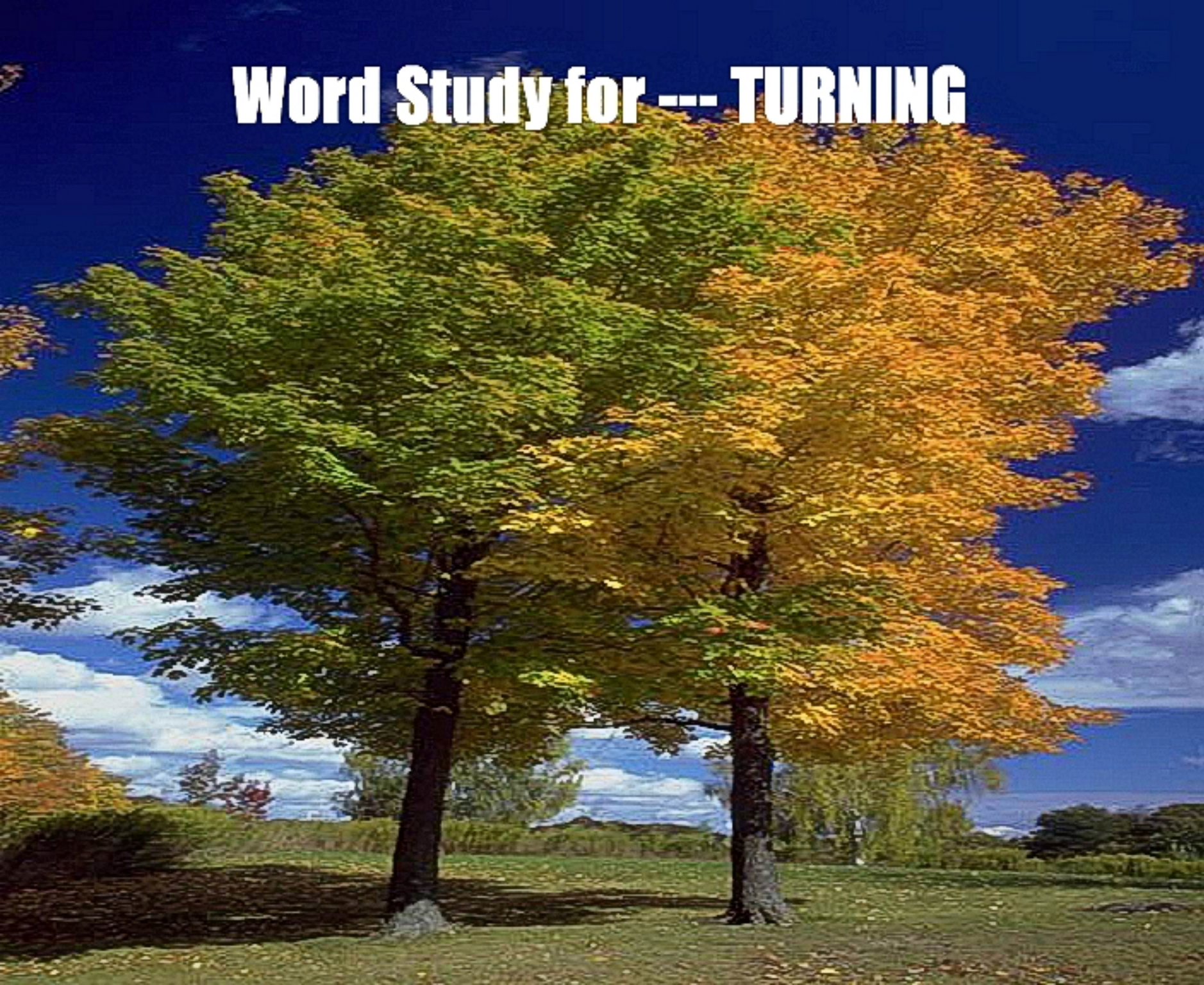





2Ch 26:09 Moreover Uzziah built towers in Jerusalem at the corner gate, and at the valley gate, and at the turning [of the wall], and fortified them





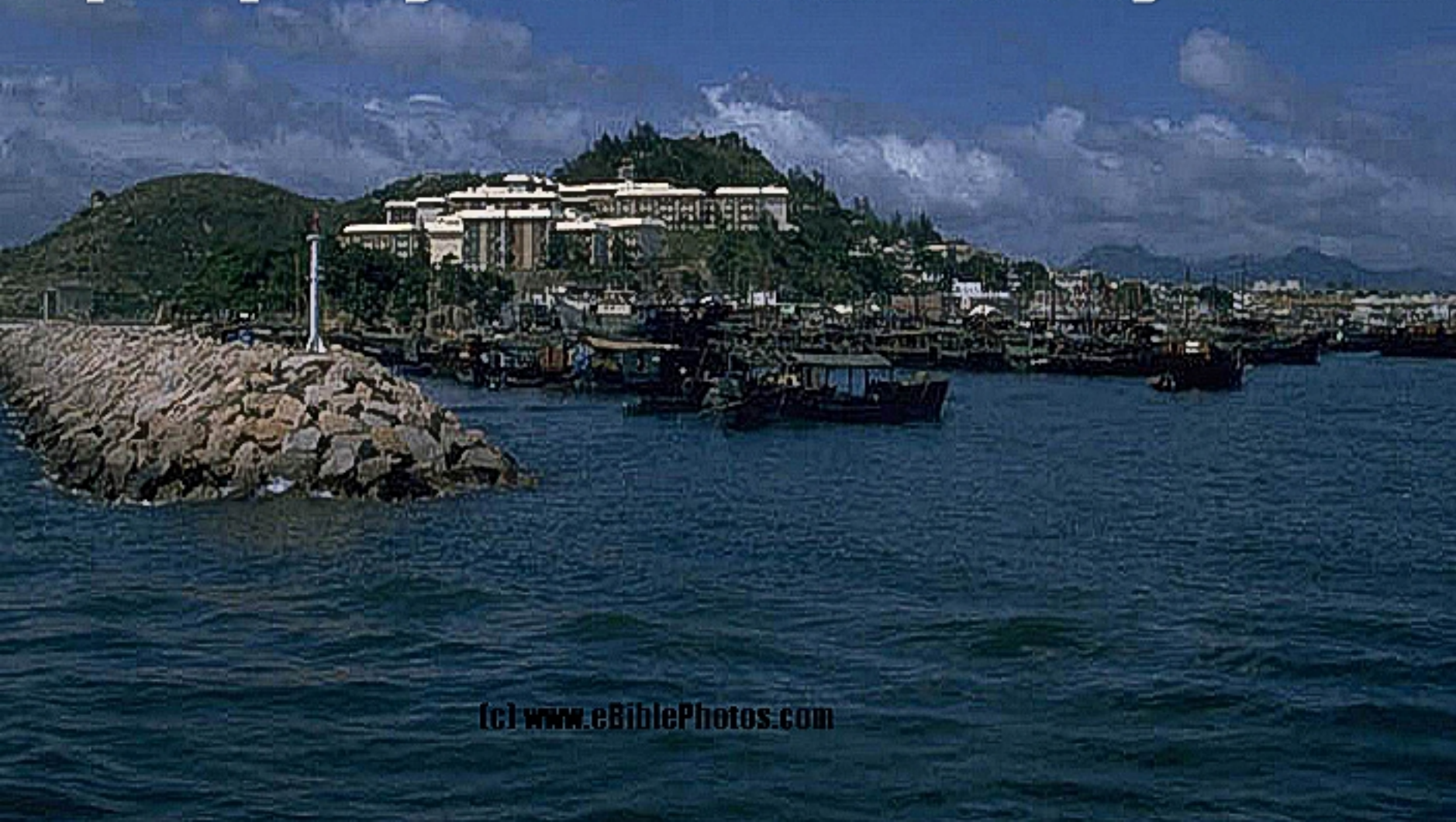
**Neh 03:20 After him Baruch the son of

and for your children.**


