


# **Word Study for --- WASHED**

**Gen 43:24 And the man brought the men  
into Joseph's house, and gave them  
water, and they washed their feet; and  
he gave their asses provender.**

**Gen 43:31 And he washed his face, and  
went out, and refrained himself, and  
said, Set on bread.**



**Gen 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine,  
and his ass's colt unto the choice vine;  
he washed his garments in wine, and  
his clothes in the blood of grapes**



**Exo 19:14 And Moses went down from  
the mount unto the people, and  
sanctified the people; and they  
washed their clothes.**

**Exo 40:31 And Moses and Aaron and his  
sons washed their hands and their  
feet thereat:**

**Exo 40:32 When they went into the tent  
of the congregation, and when they  
came near unto the altar, they  
washed: as the LORD commanded  
Moses.**

**Lev 08:06 And Moses brought Aaron  
and his sons, and washed them with

LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.**



**Lev 13:58 And the garment, either  
warp, or woof, or whatsoever thing of  
skin it be, which thou shalt wash, if  
the plague be departed from them,  
then it shall be washed the second  
time, and shall be clean.**

**Lev 15:17 And every garment, and every skin, whereon is the seed of copulation, shall be washed with water, and be unclean until the even.**

**Num 08:21 And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them as an offering before the LORD; and Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them.**

**Jud 19:21 So he brought him into his house, and gave provender unto the asses: and they washed their feet, and did eat and drink.**



**2Sa 12:20 Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed himself, and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.**

**2Sa 19:24 And Mephibosheth the son  
of Saul came down to meet the king,  
and had neither dressed his feet, nor  
trimmed his beard, nor washed his  
clothes, from the day the King  
departed until the day he came [again]  
in peace.**

**1Ki 22:38 And [on]el washed the chariot  
in the pool of Samaria; and the dogs

his armour; according unto the word  
of the LORD which he spake.**

**2Ch 04:06 He made also ten lavers,  
and put five on the right hand, and five  
on the left, to wash in them: such  
things as they offered for the burnt  
offering they washed in them; but the  
sea {was} for the priests to wash in.**

**Job 29:06 When I washed my steps  
with butter, and the rock poured me  
out rivers of oil;**

**Psa 73:13 Verily I have cleansed my

is not washed from their filthiness.**




**Son 05:03 I have put off my coat; how

thee with oil.**




**Luk 07:44 And he turned to the woman,

and do see.**


**Joh 13:10 Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash [his] feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.**

**Joh 13:12 So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you?**


**Joh 13:14 If I then, [your] Lord and
