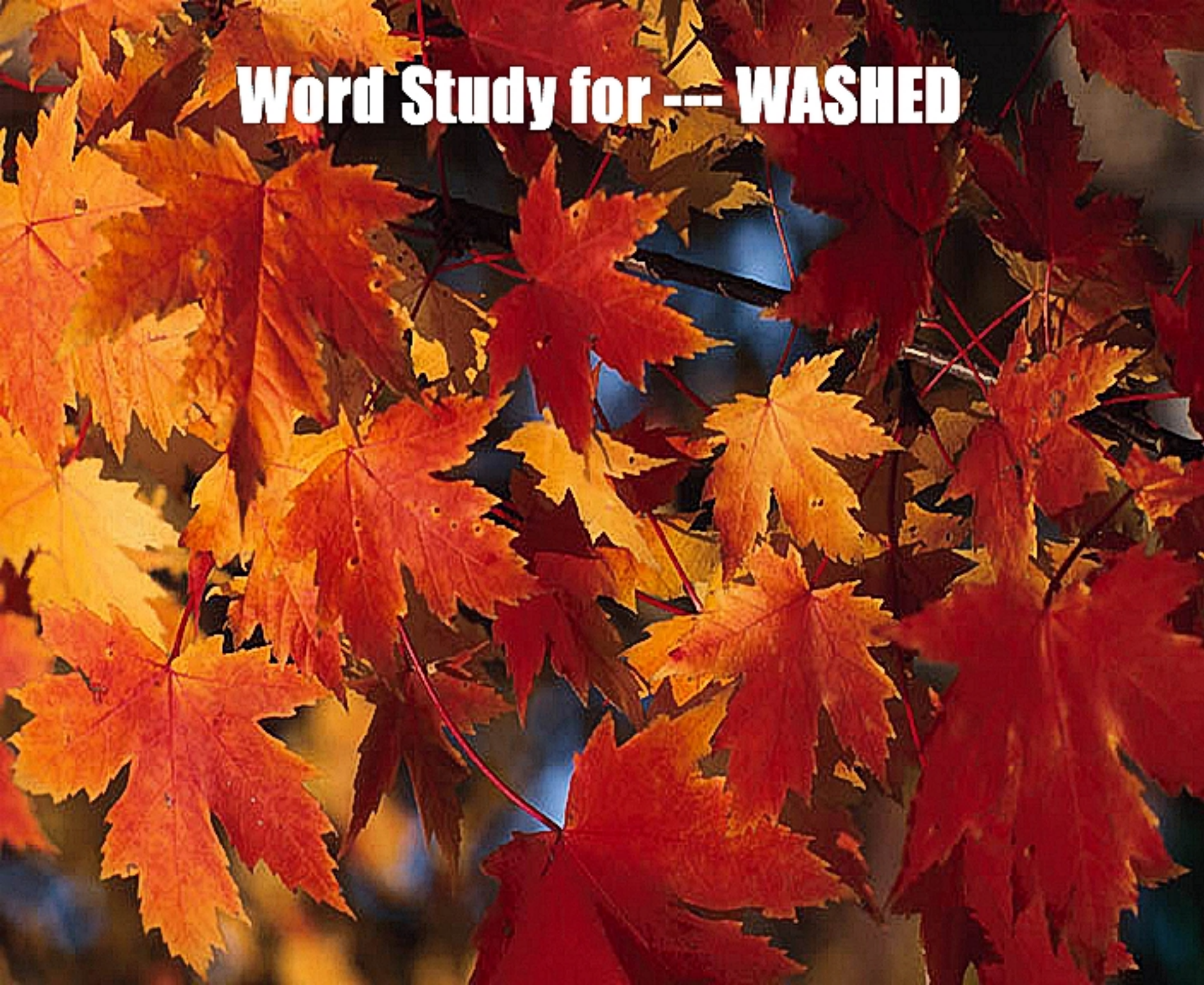



his clothes in the blood of grapes.**




