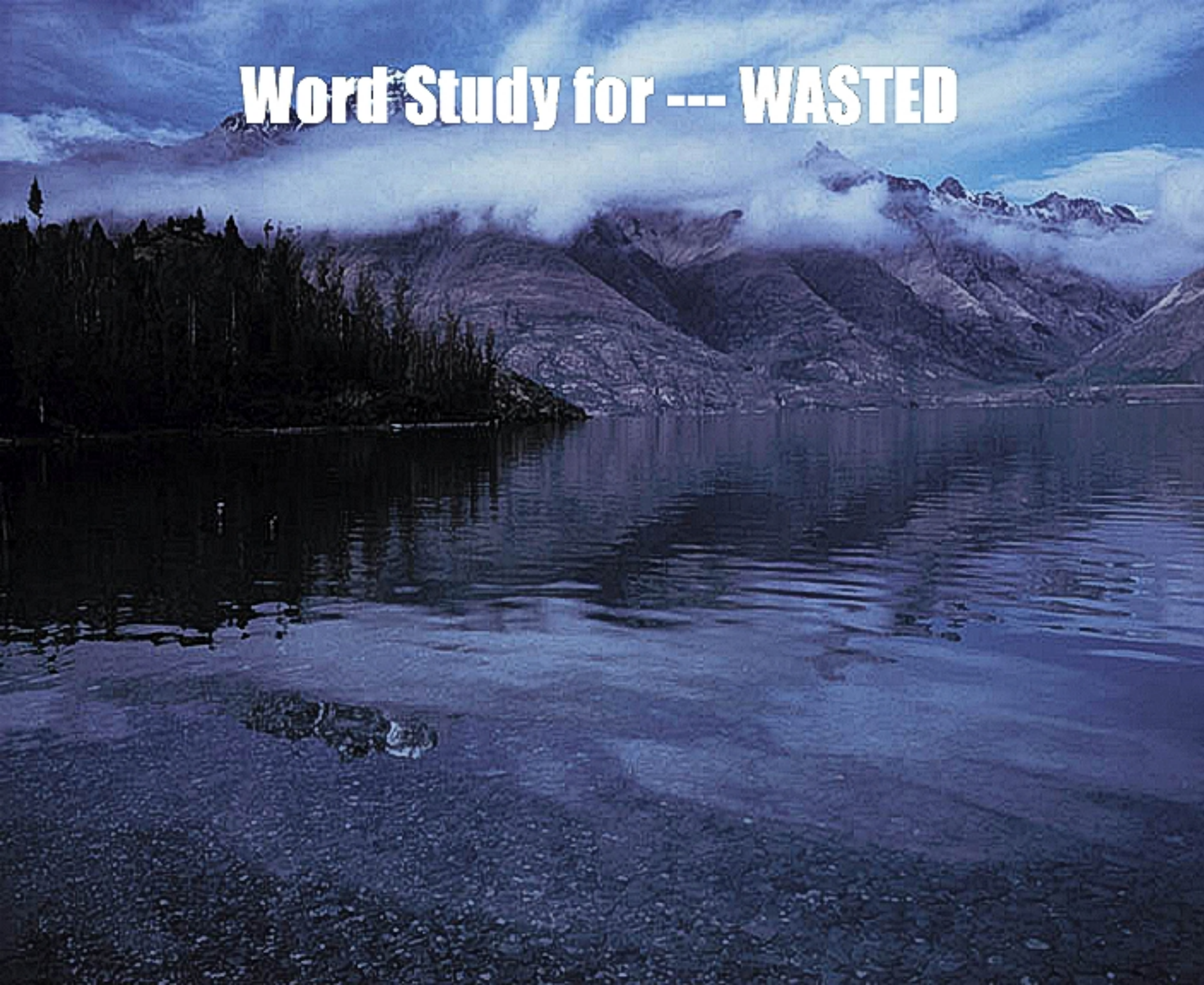

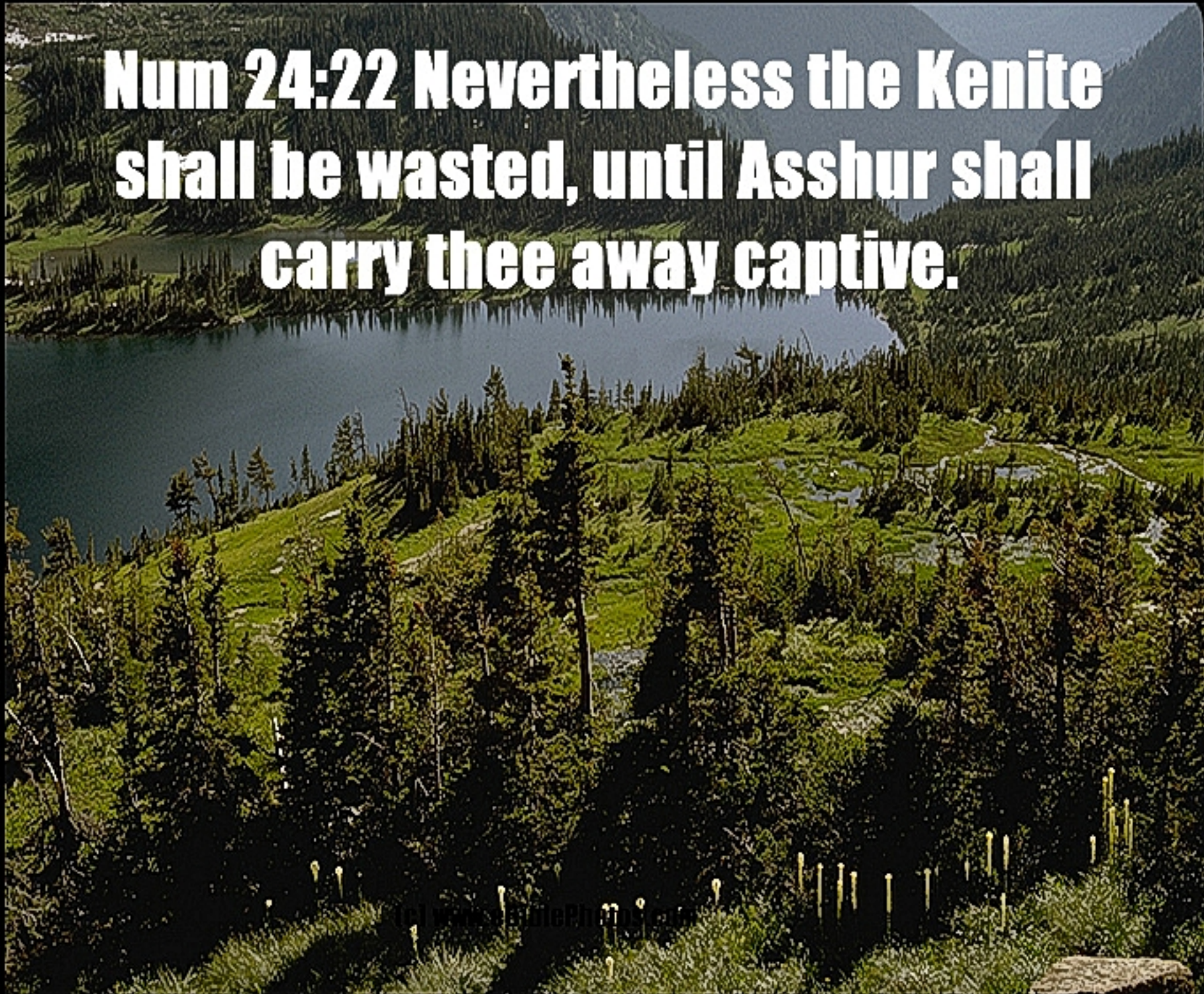
Word Study for --- WASTED




