



Gen 23:16 And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current money with the merchant.



Num 07:85 Each charger of silver [weighing] an hundred and thirty [shekels], each bowl seventy: all the silver vessels [weighed] two thousand and four hundred [shekels], after the shekel of the sanctuary:

1Sa 02:03 Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let [not] arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD [is] a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.


1Sa 17:07 And the staff of his spear was like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head weighed six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him.

**2Sa 14:26 And when he polled his head,
for it was at every year's end that he
polled it : because the hair was heavy

weighed the hair of his head at two
hundred shekels after the king's weight.**

**2Sa 21:16 And Ishbibenob, which [was]
of the sons of the giant, the weight of
whose spear [weighed] three hundred
[shekels] of brass in weight, he being
girded with a new [sword], thought to
have slain David.**

Ezr 08:25 And weighed unto them the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, [even] the offering of the house of our God, which the king, and his counsellors, and his lords, and all Israel [therel] present, had offered:

Ezr 08:26 I even weighed unto their hand six hundred and fifty talents of silver, and silver vessels an hundred talents, landl of gold an hundred talents;




**Ezr 08:33 Now on the fourth day was
