



Word Study for --- WIPE

**2Ki 21:13 And I will stretch over
Jerusalem the line of Samaria, and the
plummet of the house of Ahab: and I
will wipe Jerusalem as [a man] wipeth
a dish, wiping [it], and turning [it]
upside down.**

**Neh 13:14 Remember me, O my God,
concerning this, and wipe not out my
good deeds that I have done for the
house of my God, and for the offices
thereof.**
