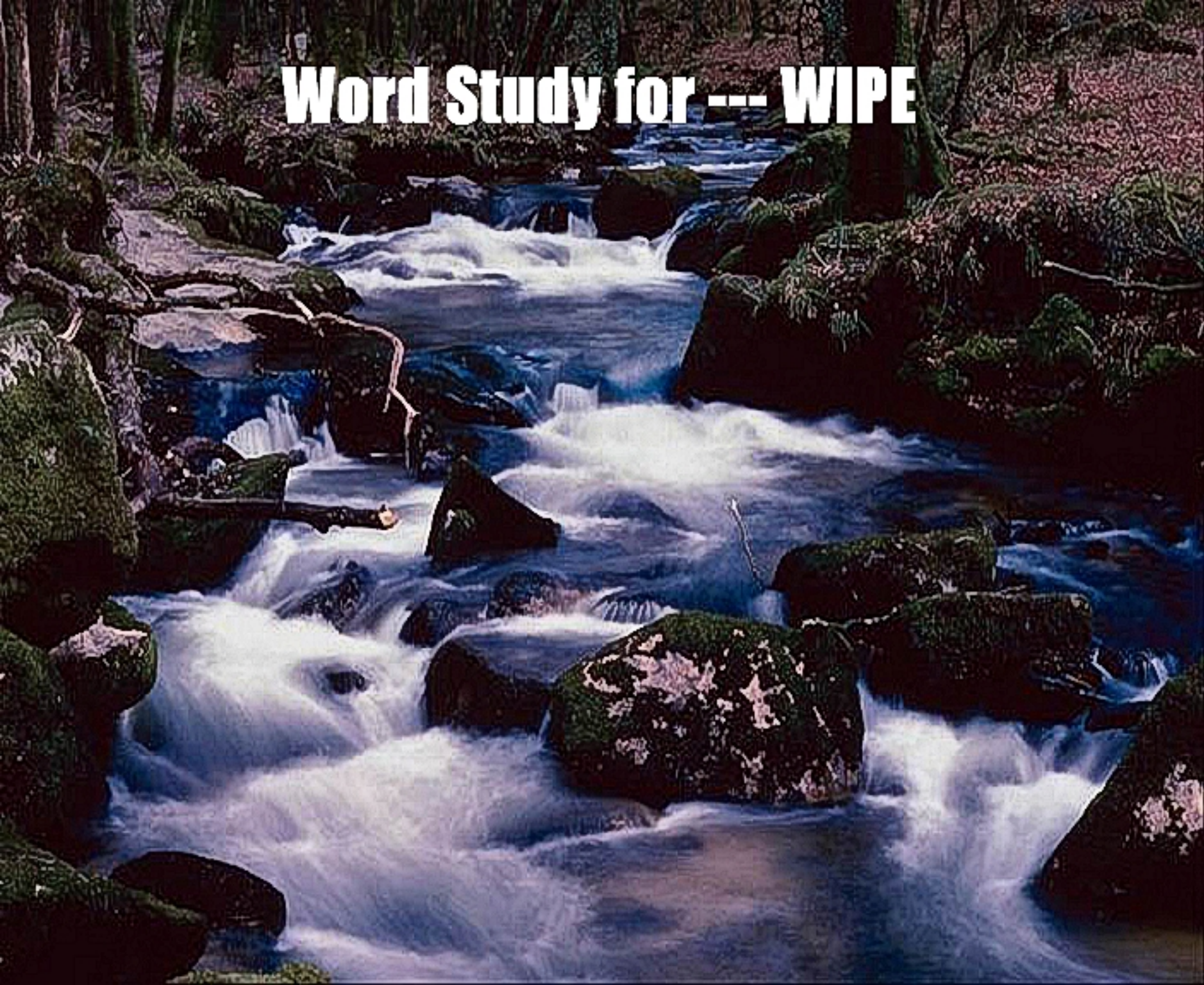




**2Ki 21:13 And I will stretch over

thereof.**


