

**Gen 24:21 And the man wondering at her
held his peace, to wit whether the LORD
had made his journey prosperous or
not.**

**Exo 02:04 And his sister stood afar off,
to wit what would be done to him.**

**Jos 17:01 There was also a lot for the
tribe of Manasseh; for he was the
firstborn of Joseph: to wit, for Machir,
the firstborn of Manasseh, the father of
Gilead: because he was a man of war,
therefore he had Gilead and Bashan.**

1KI 02:32 And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing thereof, to wit, Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

1Ki 07:50 And the bowls, and the snuffers, and the basins, and the spoons, and the censers [of] pure gold; and the hinges [of] gold, [both] for the doors of the inner house, the most holy [place, and] for the doors of the house, [to wit, of the temple.]

the women;]**


**Jer 25:8 To wit, Jerusalem, and the
