

# Word Study for -- WITHAL



**Exo 25:29 And thou shalt make the  
dishes thereof, and spoons thereof,  
and covers thereof, and bowls thereof,  
to cover withal: lo! I ofl pure gold shalt  
thou make them.**

**Exo 30:04 And two golden rings shalt thou make to it under the crown of it, by the two corners thereof, upon the two sides of it shalt thou make [it]; and they shall be for places for the staves to bear it withal.**

**Exo 30:18 Thou shalt also make a laver  
of brass, and his foot [also of] brass,  
to wash [withall]: and thou shalt put it  
between the tabernacle of the  
congregation and the altar, and thou  
shalt put water therein.**

**Exo 36:03 And they received of Moses all the offering, which the children of Israel had brought for the work of the service of the sanctuary, to make it [withal]. And they brought yet unto him free offerings every morning.**

**Exo 37:16 And he made the vessels  
which [werel upon the table, his  
dishes, and his spoons, and his bowls,  
and his covers to cover withal, lof]

**Exo 40:30 And he set the laver  
between the tent of the congregation  
and the altar, and put water there, to  
wash [with]all.**

**Lev 05:03 Or if he touch the uncleanness of man, whatsoever uncleanness [it be] that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty.**


**Jud 07:20 And the three companies


**Job 02:08 And he took him a potsherd
