


**Word Study for --- WRAPPED**

**Gen 38:14 And she put her widow's garments off from her, and covered her with a veil, and wrapped herself, and sat in an open place, which is by the way to Timnath; for she saw that Shelah was grown, and she was not given unto him to wife.**

**1Sa 21:09 And the priest said, The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom thou slewest in the valley of Elah, behold, it [is here] wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod: if thou wilt take that, take it: for [there is] no other save that here. And David said, [There is] none like that; give it me.**

**1Ki 19:13 And it was Isol, when Elijah heard [it] that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entering in of the cave. And, behold, there came a voice unto him, and said, What doest thou here, Elijah?**


**Jon 02:05 The waters compassed me about, [even] to the soul: the depth closed me round about, the weeds were wrapped about my head.**
