But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: 45 ROM 05 21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. 45 ROM 07 24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death? 45 ROM 07 25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
