- 43_JOH_03_17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him r be saved.
- 43_JOH_06_51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live fe ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

- 48_GAL_04_04 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made und law,
- 48_GAL_04_05 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.
- 49_EPH_01_07 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of grace;
- 49_EPH_02_13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.
- 49_EPH_02_14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;
- 49_EPH_02_15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinance to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;
- 49_EPH_02_16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity the
- 49_EPH_02_17 And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.
- 49_EPH_02_18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.
- 49_EPH_02_19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of household of God;
- 49_EPH_05_02 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sa to God for a sweetsmelling savour.
- 49_EPH_05_25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;
- 51_COL_01_14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:
- 51_COL_01_20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himse him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.
- 51_COL_01_21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hat reconciled
- 51_COL_01_22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable sight:
- 52_1TH_05_09 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 52_1TH_05_10 Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- 54_1TI_01_15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to sa sinners; of whom I am chief.
- 54_1TI_02_05 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- 54_1TI_02_06 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.
- 56_TIT_02_14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peopeople, zealous of good works.
- $58_HEB_01_03$ Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all this $\frac{1}{1}$

- the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on his 58_HEB_02_09 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.
- 58_HEB_02_14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took pathe same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;
- 58_HEB_02_15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
- 58_HEB_02_16 For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.
- 58_HEB_02_17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a men and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.
- 58_HEB_07_27 Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself.
- 58_HEB_09_07 But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offer himself, and for the errors of the people:
- 58_HEB_09_11 But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabe not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;
- 58_HEB_09_12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy playing obtained eternal redemption for us.
- 58_HEB_09_14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
- 58_HEB_09_15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the reden of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eter inheritance.
- 58_HEB_09_22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no ren
- 58_HEB_09_28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he ap the second time without sin unto salvation.
- 58_HEB_10_12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of G
- 58_HEB_12_24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh bet things than that of Abel.

- 60_1PE_01_18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;
- 60_1PE_01_19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:
- 60_1PE_02_24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should liv righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
- 60_1PE_03_18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the spirit:
