altern 1325 - didomi {did'-o-mee}; a prolonged form of a primary verb (which is used as an {altern}. in most of the tenses); to give (used in a very wide application, properly, or by implication, literally or figuratively; greatly modified by the connection): -- adventure, bestow, bring forth, commit, deliver (up), give, grant, hinder, make, minister, number, offer, have power, put, receive, set, shew, smite (+ with the hand), strike (+ with the palm of the hand), suffer, take, utter, yield.

altern 1643 - elauno {el-ow'-no}; a prolonged form of a primary verb (obsolete except in certain tenses as an {altern}. of this) of uncertain affin; to push (as wind, oars or demonic power): -- carry, drive, row.

alternate 3663 - homoiopathes {hom-oy-op-ath-ace'}; from 3664 and the {alternate} of 3958; similarly

affected: -- of (subject to) like passions.

alternate 3685 - oninemi {on-in'-ay-mee}; a prolonged form of an apparently primary verb (onomai, to slur); for which another prolonged form (onao) is used as an {alternate} in some tenses [unless indeed it be identical with the base of 3686 through the idea of notoriety]; to gratify, i.e. (middle voice) to derive pleasure or advantage from: -- have joy.

alternate 3997 - penthos {pen'-thos}; strengthened from the {alternate} of 3958; grief: -- mourning, sorrow.

alternate 4006 - pepoithesis {pep-oy'-thay-sis}; from the perfect of the {alternate} of 3958; reliance: -- confidence, trust.

alternate 4014 - periaireo {per-ee-ahee-reh'-o}; from 4012 and 0138 (including its {alternate}); to remove all around, i.e. unveil, cast off (anchor); figuratively, to explate: -- take away (up).

alternate 4022 - perierchomai {per-ee-er'-khom-ahee}; from 4012 and 2064 (including its {alternate}); to come all around, i.e. stroll, vacillate, veer: -- fetch a compass, vagabond, wandering about.
