await 4327 - prosdechomai {pros-dekh'-om-ahee}; from 4314 and 1209; to admit (to intercourse, hospitality, credence, or [figuratively] endurance); by implication, to {await} (with confidence or patience): -- accept, allow, look (wait) for, take.

await 4328 - prosdokao {pros-dok-ah'-o}; from 4314 and dokeuo (to watch); to anticipate (in thought, hope or fear); by implication, to {await}: -- (be in) expect(-ation), look (for), when looked, tarry, wait for.

await 4692 - speudo {spyoo'-do}; probably strengthened from 4228; to "speed" ("study"), i.e. urge on (diligently or earnestly); by implication, to {await} eagerly: -- (make, with) haste unto.
